Gwinnett County covers 437 square miles in northeastern Georgia and is 30 miles northeast of downtown Atlanta. Interstate 85 is the county's main artery and connects to Highway 316, I-285 (the Perimeter), and I-985. Fulton, Forsyth, Barrow, Walton, Hall, Rockdale, and DeKalb counties border Gwinnett.

Currently, Gwinnett County has more than 800,000 residents and operates on a \$1.3 billion budget. Gwinnett leads the state in population and job growth with an economic strategy of balancing vigorous, quality economic expansion with civic improvements, and strong support of education, the arts, and community service. Gwinnett County Government, also maintains the distinction of being one of the few counties in the United States with a AAA bond rating from all three of the major rating agencies.
