The Gwinnett County Board of Commissioners is soliciting competitive sealed bids from qualified contractors for the **Hog Mountain No. 1 and Dacula Road Pump Stations Odor Control Projects**. Sealed bids will be received by the Gwinnett County Department of Financial Services - Purchasing Division – 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, 75 Langley Drive, Lawrenceville, Georgia 30046 until **2:50 P.M. local time on October 11, 2011** and then publicly opened and read aloud at 3:00 P.M. Any bid received after 2:50 P.M. will not be accepted. Bid envelope must be marked on the outside with Bid Number, name of Bidder, date and time of opening. Contractor providing the utility work must have a current valid Utility Contractors License.

Installation of a new Biofilter odor control system at the Hog Mountain No. 1 Pump Station and installation of a new carbon adsorber odor control system at the Dacula Road Pump Station including stainless steel air ducts, grease filter/mist eliminator, new concrete equipment pads, relocation of existing conduits and cables, modifications to the existing electrical system, removal of a portion of existing fencing, installation of new fencing, installation of new roller gate, installation of new water supply piping and drain piping, electrical and controls work, earthwork and erosion control, installation of a new crushed stone driveway, and related appurtenances as shown on the drawings or technical specs.

A **pre-bid conference** is scheduled for 10:00 A.M. on September 7, 2011 at the Gwinnett County Purchasing Division, above address. A site visit will be conducted immediately following the pre-bid. **All pre-qualified bidders are strongly urged to attend.**

**NOTE: Bids submitted by contractors who have not been prequalified under the Annual Prequalification of Contractors for Pump Station Construction, Rehabilitation and Replacement Projects will not be accepted.**

Questions regarding bids should be submitted to Susan Clarke, CPPB, Purchasing Associate III, at fax 770-822-8728, or email susan.clarke@gwinnettcountry.com no later than 3:00 p.m. local time, Septmeber 9, 2011. Bids are legal and binding upon the bidder when submitted.

Bids in the case of Corporations not chartered in Georgia, must be accompanied by proper certification stating that said Corporation is authorized to do business in the State of Georgia.

No Bidder may withdraw his Bid within sixty (60) days after the actual date of the opening thereof.

Bidder agrees to complete the Contract awarded within the "allowable calendar days for completion" from the date of the "Notice to Proceed" and he further agrees that the Owner may retain from the monies which may become due the amount of **\$1,000.00** per day for each and every day that the completion of the work may be delayed.

All Bidders are required to submit a Bid Bond or a certified check made payable to the Gwinnett County Board of Commissioners in the amount of five percent (5%) of the total amount bid. The Bid Bond or certified check must be enclosed in the envelope with the sealed bid. The successful bidder will be required to furnish a contract Performance Bond and Payment Bond, each in the sum of 100% of the total amount bid and provide insurance coverage as required by the contract documents.

Bonding Company must be licensed to do business in Georgia, licensed to do business by the Georgia Secretary of State, authorized to do business in Georgia by the Georgia Insurance Department, listed in the Department of the Treasury's Publication of Companies Holding Certificates of Authority as Acceptable Surety on Federal Bonds and as Acceptable Reinsuring Companies and have an A.M. Best rating of A-V or higher.

All bonds must be submitted on forms provided by Gwinnett County and agencies providing bonds and insurance should provide proof that they meet the criteria outlined in the bid and contract documents.

The County will award the Contract to the lowest "qualified" bidder, subject with the Owner's right to reject any or all bids, to waive technicalities, and to make an award deemed in its best interests. With limited response, Gwinnett County reserves the right to extend the solicitation opening date as appropriate in order to assure a competitive procurement process.
