OFFICIALS CUT RIBBON FOR FIRE ACADEMY EDUCATIONAL BUILDING

WHAT: The Gwinnett County Board of Commissioners will hold a ribbon cutting for the new Educational Building that is part of the Fire Academy Phase 2 expansion.

WHEN: Tuesday, Oct. 20, 2015, at 3:45 p.m.

WHO: Fire Chief Casey Snyder will emcee the event and remarks will be provided by Board of Commissioners Chairman Charlotte Nash and District 3 Commissioner Tommy Hunter.

WHERE: The ceremony will take place at the Fire Academy Educational Building at 3608 Braselton Highway in Dacula.

WHY: The new building consists of eight large training rooms and houses a student resource center, kitchen and conference room. The project is funded by the voter-approved 2009 SPLOST sales tax.
