


Braselton Multimodal Bridge

Rodgers Bridge

- Groundbreaking in March 2021 after extended period of contracting with GDOT and contractor.
 - Current Federal Contribution - \$5,127,456
 - Current State Contribution - \$737,000
 - Current Local Contribution - \$1,400,000 (covers match and contingencies)
- Anticipated completion date is October 2022.



Rodgers Bridge


- Launched extensive public involvement program that resulted in the selection of the “Replica Truss” as the preferred alternative.



Road Resurfacing


- Patch and resurface: 27 streets, 4.83 miles.
- Preservation: Rejuvenation – 33 streets – 6.70 miles
- Crack seal: 20 streets
- Project underway to repair/replace damaged sidewalks on Buford Highway within City limits (from Baxley Point Drive north to North Berkeley Lake Road south), \$225k contract.

Destination Park

- The land for Destination Park was purchased through an IGA with Gwinnett County using SPLOST money in 2001. Four years later, SPLOST funds were used to purchase playground equipment. Now SPLOST funds will be used for improvements and installation of bathrooms in Loganville's busiest park.






