What is Recorder's Court?

- Gwinnett Recorder's Court was established in 1972 to have jurisdiction to hear traffic offenses and county ordinance violations
- Without Recorder's Court, the caseloads of State and Magistrate Court would increase exponentially
- No Jury trials

 - Three Calendar Coordinators
 - Three Bailiffs
- The Clerk of Recorder's Court
- The Solicitor's Office

- Back-up Coverage for State Court Judges



Total Submitted to Finance Department 2020


