The flood on September 21, 2009 caused significant damage to three Gwinnett County maintained bridges, requiring two to be closed immediately and immediate repair work to the third one to avoid closure. Expediting these repairs should also aid with the County's request for reimbursement by FEMA and the Federal Highway Administration. (Staff Recommendation: Approval)

9. Water Resources/Lynn Smarr

2010-0064 Award BL113-09, Crooked Creek water reclamation facility improvements, Department of Water Resources, to low bidder, Pizzagalli Construction Company, amount not to exceed \$21,360,000.00. Authorization for Chairman to execute contracts subject to approval by the Law Department and proof of authenticity of bonds. Contracts to follow award. Commission District 2/Nasuti. The Crooked Creek WRF Improvements project involves the construction of a new influent pump station and a new headworks facility at the Crooked Creek Water Reclamation Facility. The project also includes upgrades to the existing odor control facilities, new pipe from the pump station to the headworks and from the headworks to the oxidation basins, a new electrical building for the pump station, and a new influent flow meter and backflow preventer. The funding for this project comes in the form of federally funded recovery zone economic development bonds with a portion of the interest being paid from the Federal American Reinvestment and Recovery Act of 2009 (ARRA). This contract shall terminate absolutely and without further obligation on the part of the County on December 31, 2010 and at the close of each succeeding calendar year for which it may be renewed. This contract may be automatically renewed on an annual basis for four additional twelve-month terms, for a total lifetime contract term of five years, total base amount \$27,000,000.00, upon the same terms and conditions as provided for in this agreement, unless previously terminated.
