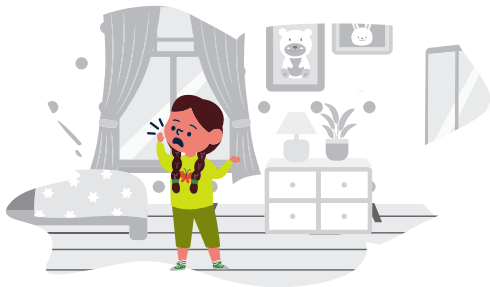


Help Ember choose

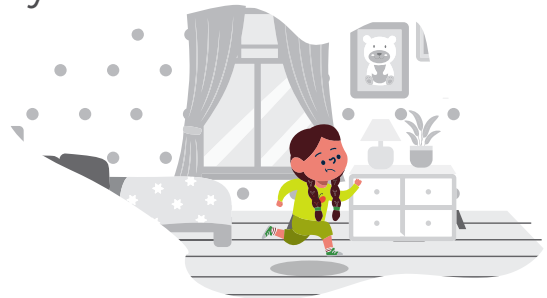
Ember's room is filling up with smoke. Help her remember what to do — quick! Look at the pictures below and circle the one that shows the safest thing for Ember to do.



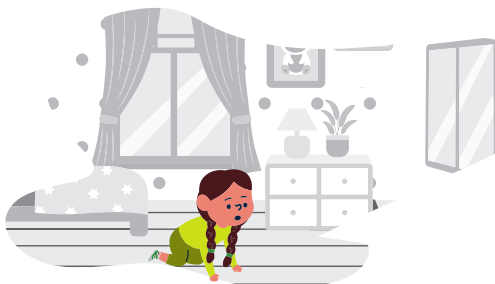
Finding her favorite toy before she leaves.

Standing up and running away fast.



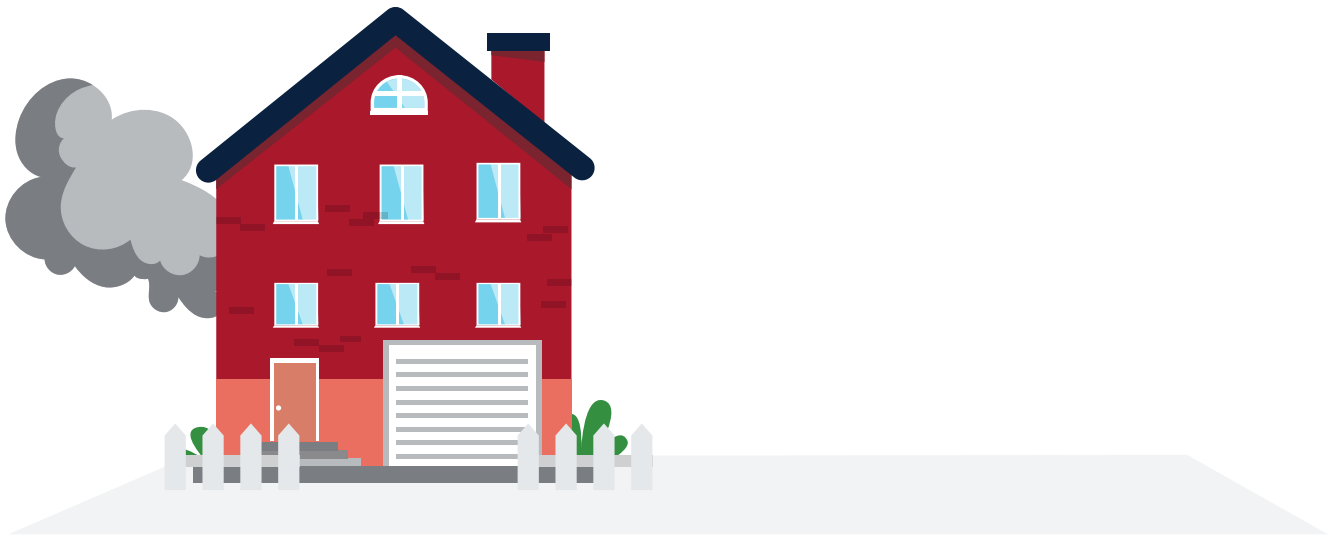
Remembering to get low and go!

My safe meeting place

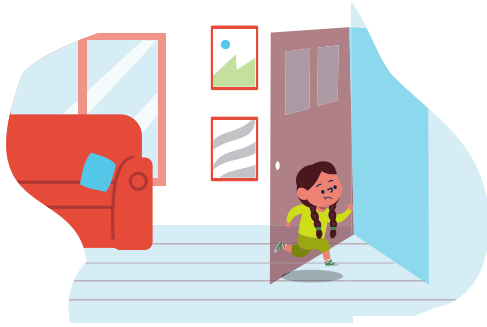

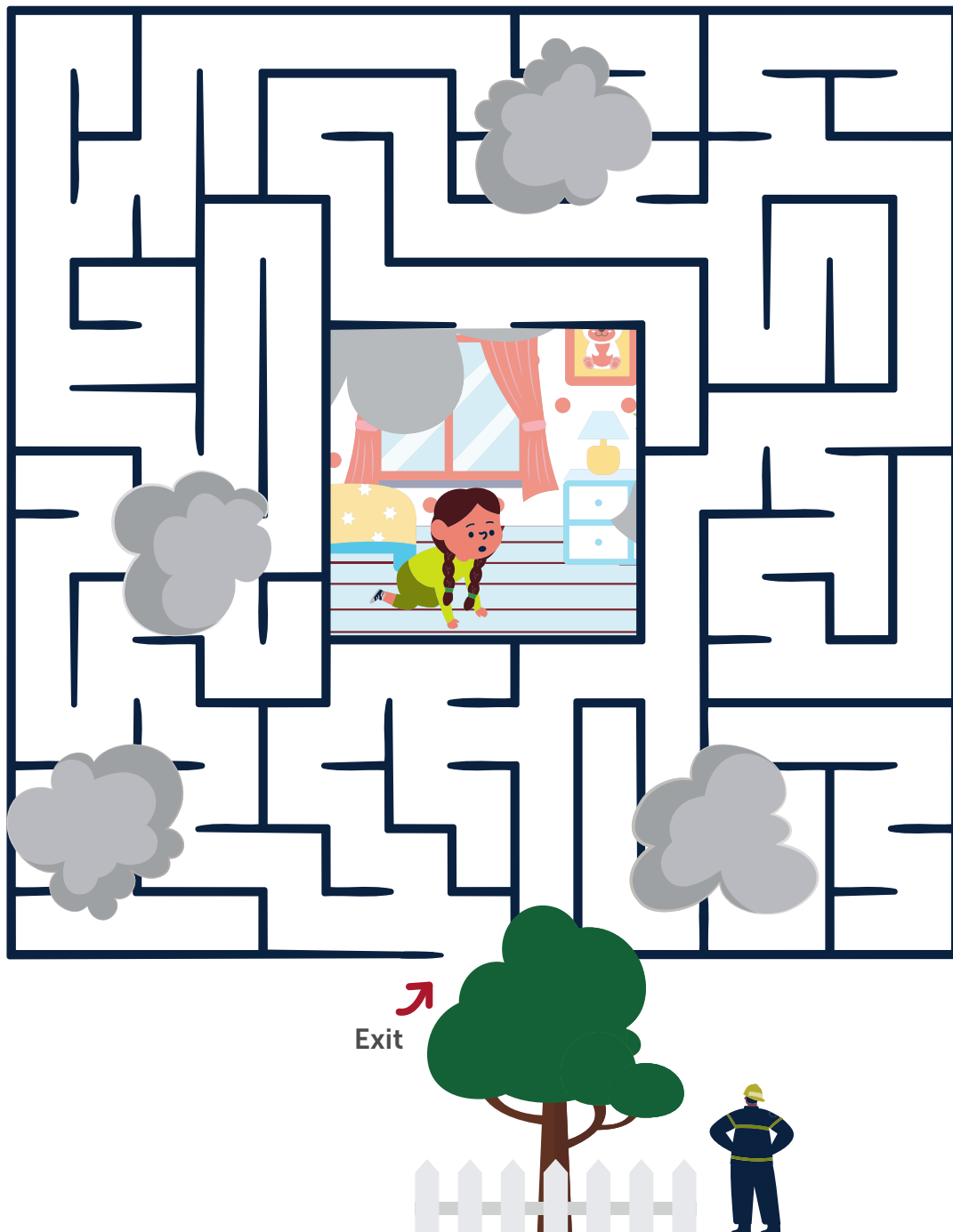

Escape the smoke maze

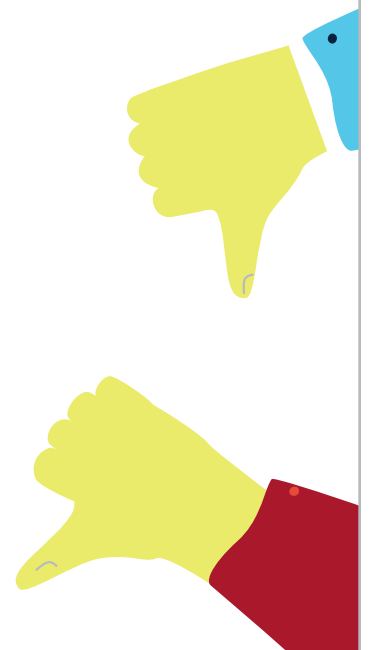
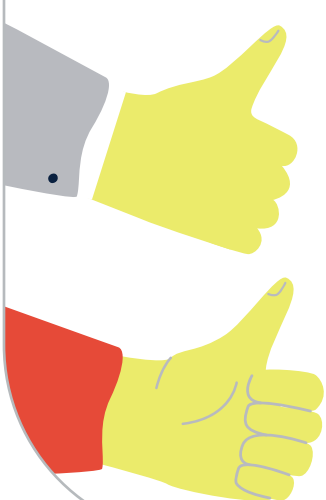
