## Register to vote in the 2026 elections

With election season underway, it's important to register to vote now. Georgia residents wishing to register must be U.S. citizens, legal residents of their voting county, and at least 18 years of age by Election Day. The deadline to vote in the May 19 General Primary Election is Monday, April 20. Check your registration status, download a voter registration application, view sample ballots, and find your polling location at [MVP.SOS.GA.gov](http://MVP.SOS.GA.gov).

## PROTECTING OUR RESOURCES

### Keep your septic system healthy

Many homeowners rely on septic systems to treat household wastewater. Septic systems separate solids in the tank and filter liquids through the drain field. When maintained, septic systems are effective and environmentally friendly. However, neglected systems can cause slow drains, gurgling toilets, or wet spots in the yard. A failing system may overflow, allowing raw sewage to reach nearby waterways and threaten public health. The best prevention is routine care:

- Pump your tank every three to five years
- Don't pour fats, oils, and grease down drains
- Avoid flushing anything other than toilet paper and human waste

## TAX COMMISSIONER

### Apply for a homestead exemption by April 1

Homeowners who occupy a home in Gwinnett as their primary residence as of January 1 may qualify for an exemption this year. A homestead exemption can significantly reduce your property tax bill. If you're unsure whether you have an exemption, we can help determine your eligibility and the best exemption for you. ## PUBLIC SAFETY

### Avoid tax scams

Each tax filing season, scammers pose as IRS agents to trick residents into sharing personal information. By sharing this information, your life savings could be compromised. Avoid tax scams with these helpful tips:

- Choose tax preparers with caution and research before handing over your information
- Watch for unsolicited emails, texts, and fake websites that might prompt you to click a link or share personal information
- Be on alert for phone scams; IRS representatives will never demand payments over the phone or leave threatening messages

## SPLOST

### Enhancements underway at Evermore North Boulevard

Gwinnett County is making improvements to Evermore North Boulevard, enhancing mobility for commuters. A two-lane road will be constructed on the north side, running parallel to US 78 from Hewatt Road to Britt Drive, and will serve as an alternate route for drivers. It also includes the installation of a roundabout at the intersection of Parkwood Road and Evermore North Boulevard and the installation of a new pump station and sanitary sewer main. Partially funded by SPLOST, the project is anticipated to be complete by mid-2026.

Gwinnett County offers five warming stations for residents to receive temporary, overnight relief from long-term exposure to frigid temperatures.
