Council Chambers HVAC Replacement

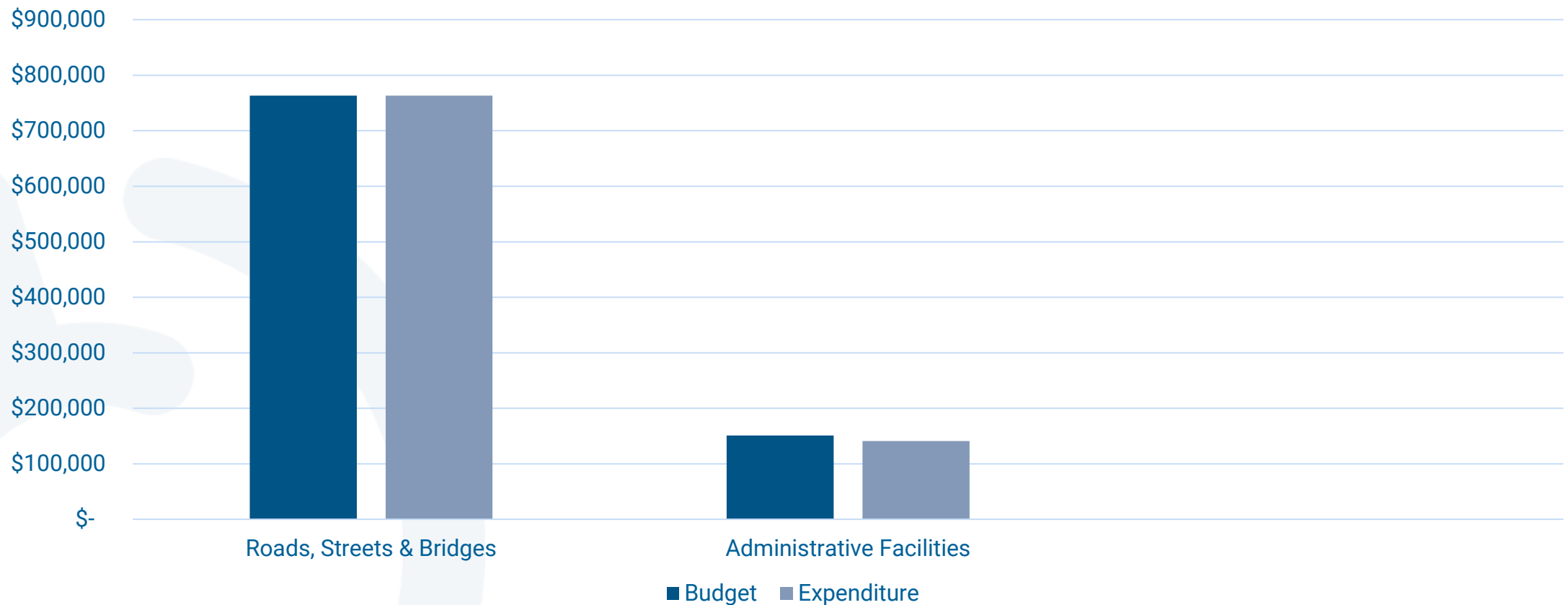


- The HVAC for council chambers stopped working in the summer of 2023.

- Staff replaced the commercial unit with two residential units to provide the same level of temperature and humidity control

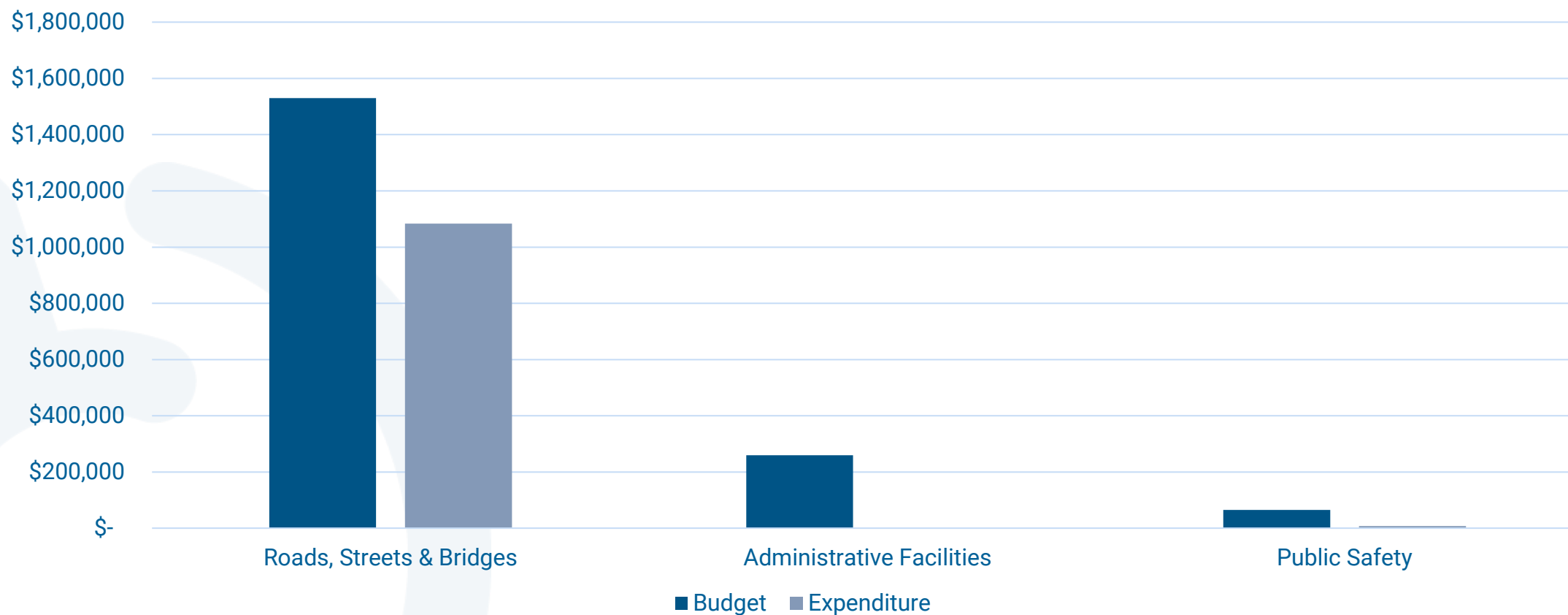

The land for Destination Park was purchased through an IGA with Gwinnett County using SPLOST money in 2001. Four years later, SPLOST funds were used to purchase playground equipment. The installation of a new restroom building and water fountain were recently completed using SPLOST funds in the City of Loganville's most popular park.



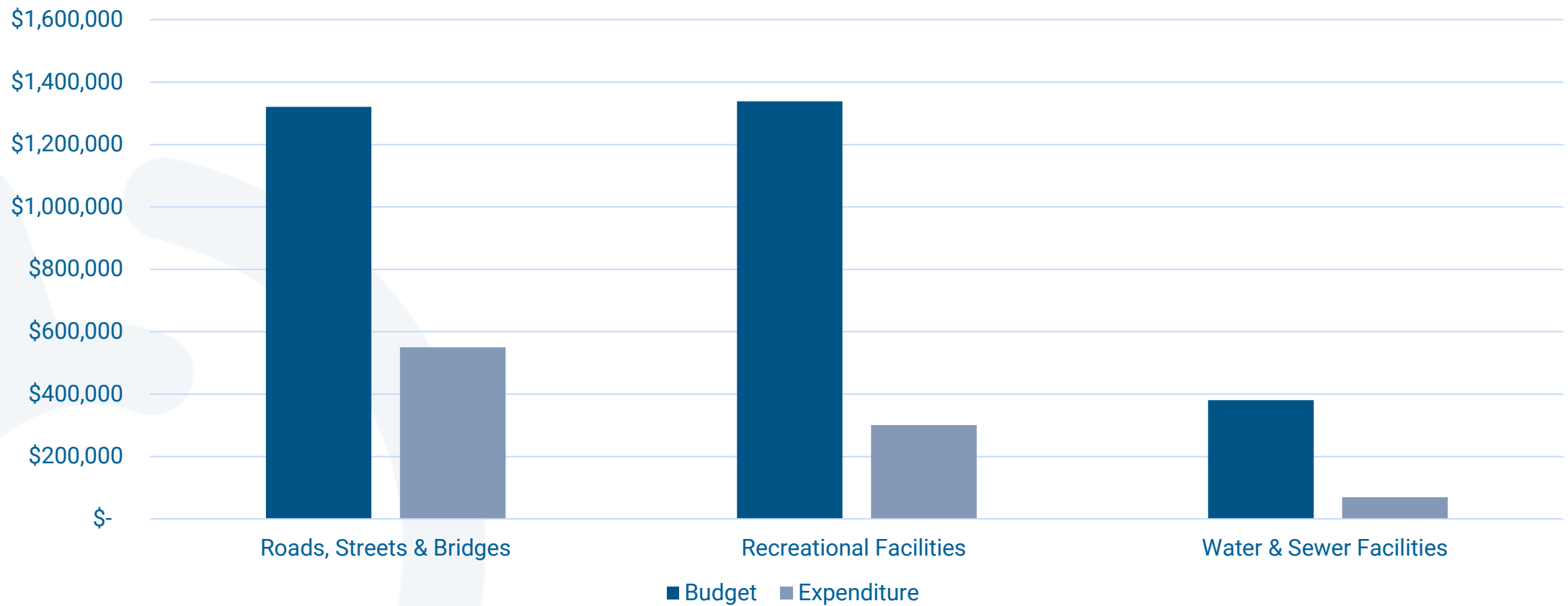


Sidewalks

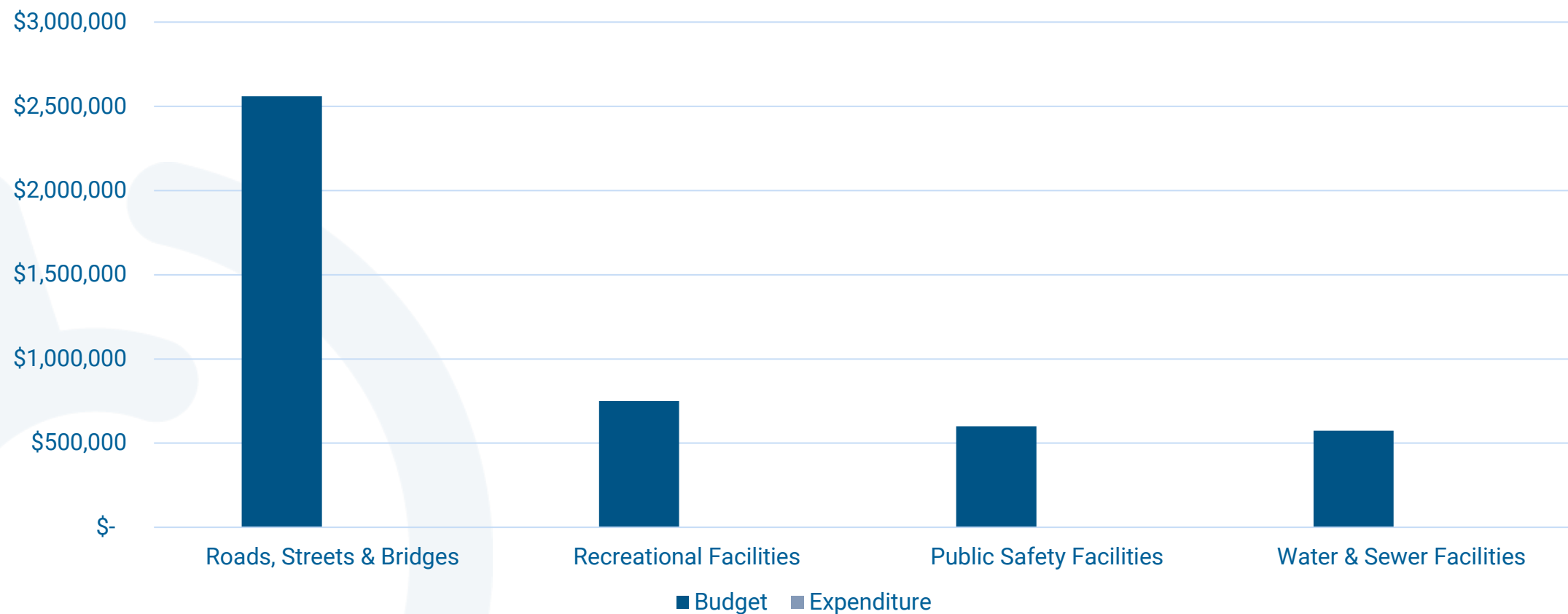
The project consisted of constructing a new sidewalk as well as curb and gutter along Old Loganville Road and Tuck Road, from Fox Chase Drive to Tom Brooks Road, along with all of the necessary stormwater infrastructure to support it. 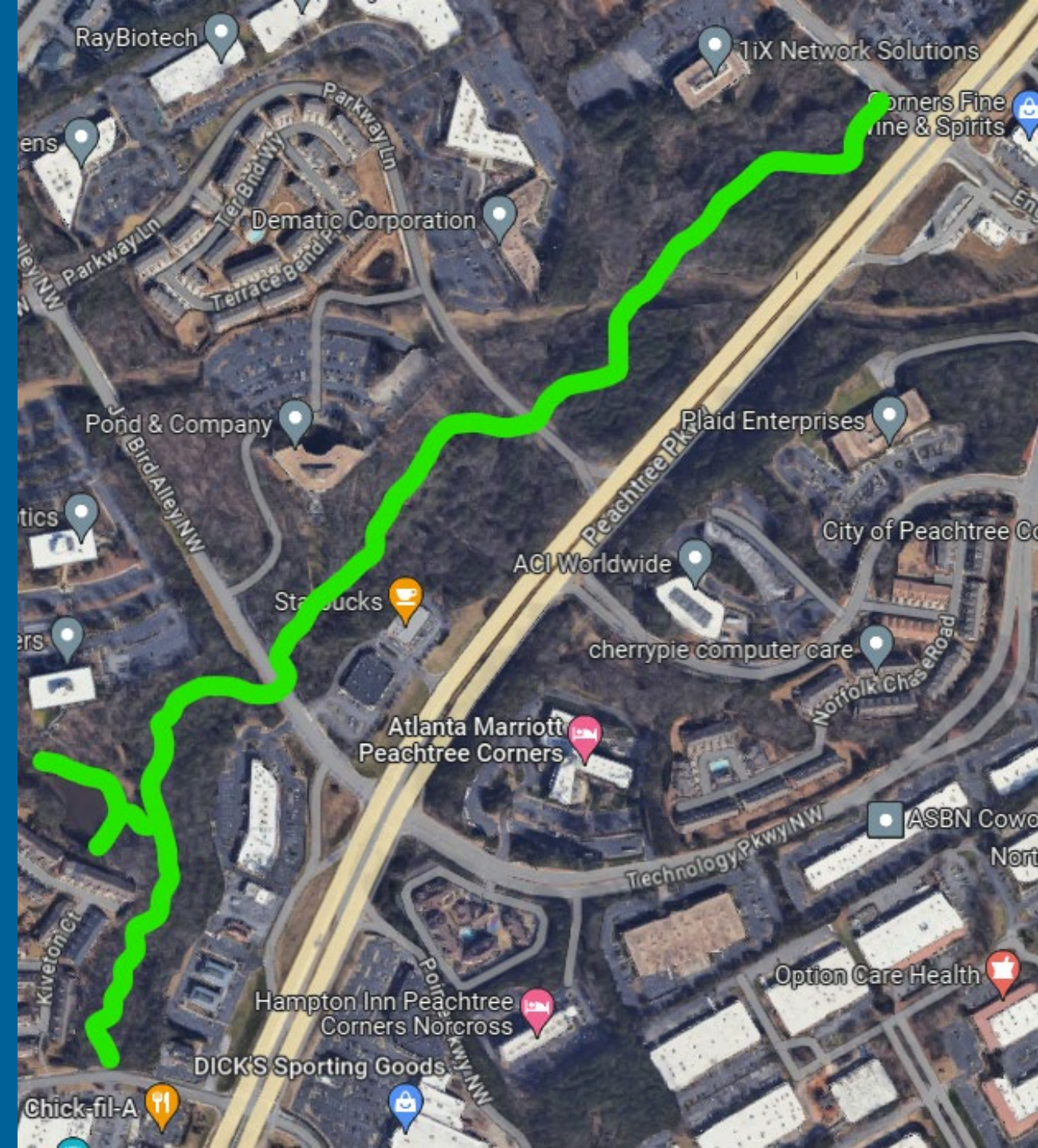


Peachtree Corners Circle Roundabout at Forum

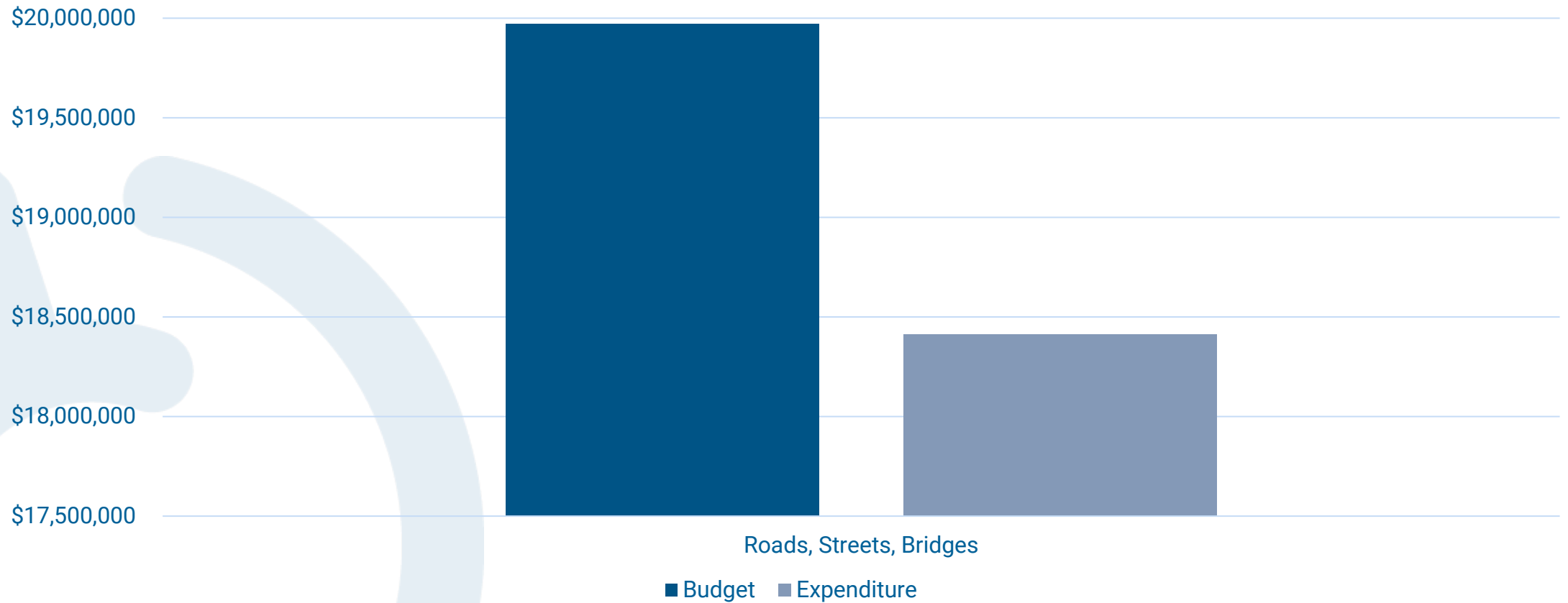




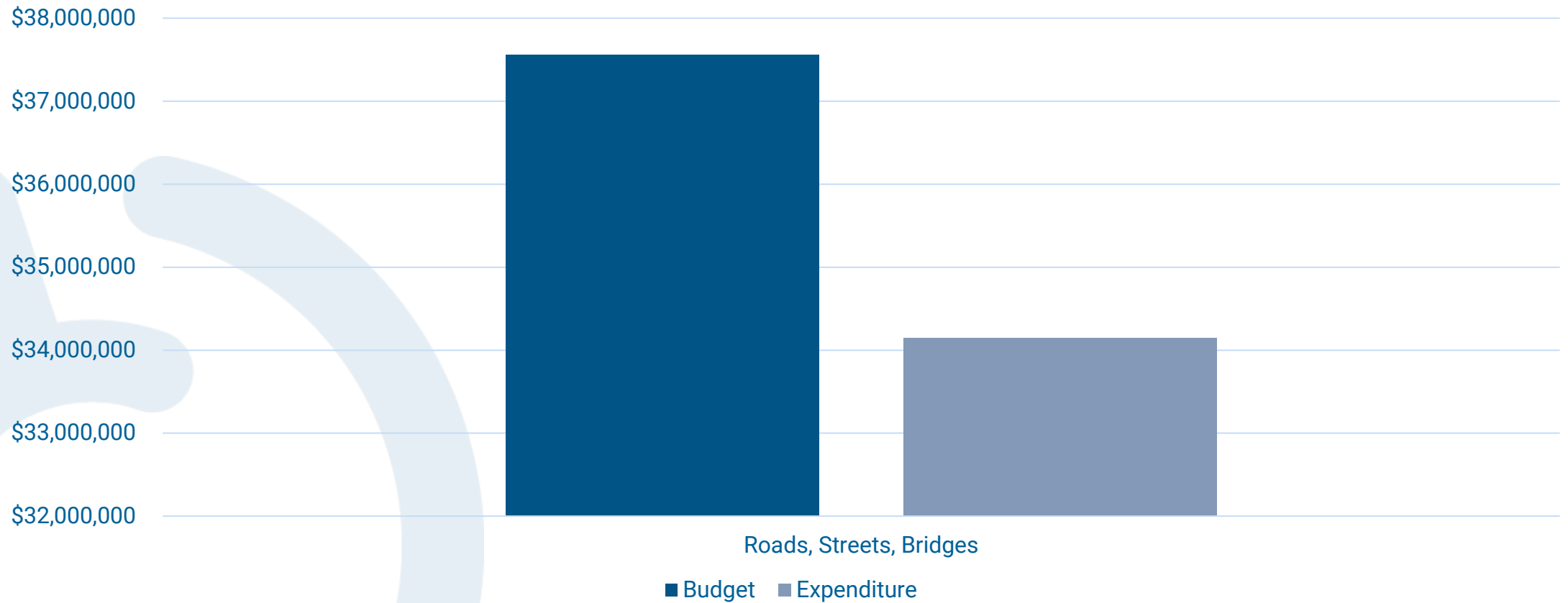
Burdell Branch – segment of PTC's 15+ mile Corners Connector Trail System
