



Grayson New Hope Road

Location of Project: Along Grayson New Hope Road, extending from the intersection with New Hope Road in the north, to approximately ½ a mile south of the intersection with Chandler Road (the location of the Grayson Water Tank) in the south.

Description of Project: The work affecting Grayson New Hope is a major water transmission main replacement project replacing 1.75 miles of 4-foot diameter pipe. Also included in the scope is 1.75 miles of 12" water main to serve the local residents. The intent of the project is to ensure long-term reliable water service for the southeastern portion of Gwinnett County.

What to Expect: Residents should expect portions of Grayson New Hope Road to be closed for the duration of the project. Please abide by the posted construction signage and speed limits. Note that local access will always be maintained to residents, businesses, and emergency services operating.

Estimated Completion: Project delays have led to a revised estimated completion date of summer 2019.

Detour Route: From Round Road to Chandler Road will close July 23, 2018, for seven months for water main improvements. The detour route will be Grayson New Hope Road to Round Road to Chandler Road to Grayson New Hope Road and the reverse. From North Round Road to New Hope Road will close for January 7, 2019, for six months for water main improvements. The detour route will be Grayson New Hope Road to Chandler Road to Bowman Road to New Hope Road to Grayson New Hope Road and the reverse. From Chandler Road to North Round Road will close November 19, 2018 for eight months for water main improvements. The detour route will be Grayson New Hope Road to North Round Road to Chandler Road to Grayson New Hope Road and the reverse.
