

Pharr Woodberry Gravity Sewer Extension

Location of Project: The project will run from the Pharr Elementary Pump Station southward, through Georgetown Way, a section of Natchez Way, Winding Creek Circle, Brookstone, a section of Pharr Road, and a section of Lakeview Road.

Description of Project: The Pharr Woodberry Gravity Sewer Extension Project will decommission two aging sewer pump stations: Pharr Elementary Pump Station and Woodberry Pump Station. This project includes installation of a gravity sewer line from Pharr Elementary school to an existing sewer pipeline on Lakeview Road, through the following: Georgetown Way, Winding Creek Circle, Brookstone Drive and section of Natchez Way. This will provide residents along these roads the opportunity to get off their septic system and tie on to the county's sewer system once the project is complete.

What to Expect: Most of the proposed sewer line will be installed within the right-of-way, with an individual sewer lateral and cleanout installed to each parcel along the way. As such, residences should expect lane closures and stakes in the yard area (within the right-of-way) to mark the proposed sewer cleanouts. Homeowners will be contacted by the contractor to confirm the location of the sewer cleanouts. If you have questions about the location, please contact the Project Manager listed below. Digging will occur along the roads mentioned with possible blasting as necessary.

Estimated Completion: Summer 2019

Detour Route: Intermittent lane closures on Georgetown Way, Natchez Way, Winding Creek Circle, Brookstone, and Pharr Road. Please use care when passing construction equipment.
