The strategic relocation of Fire Station 15 provides much needed space for the three crews it houses, which are among the busiest in the county. The new station provides room for 24-hour staffing for engine, ladder, and medic units as well as a battalion chief.

The site for the former station across from the Lawrenceville Lawn will become the Bicentennial Plaza, permanently commemorating Gwinnett's 200<sup>th</sup> year for future generations.
