


Hello!

Register to vote in the 2024 elections

With election season underway, it's crucial to register to vote now. Georgia residents wishing to register must be U.S. citizens, legal residents of their voting county, and at least 18 years of age by Election Day. The deadline to register to vote in the March 12 Presidential Preference Primary is Monday, February 12. Check your registration status, download a voter registration application, view sample ballots, and locate your polling location at MVP.SOS.GA.gov.

Happening Around Gwinnett

Chairwoman Hendrickson proposes 2024 County budget

Chairwoman Nicole Love Hendrickson presented her proposed budget in November to guide County government spending for the 2024 fiscal year. The proposed budget for 2024 totals \$2.5 billion. It consists of a \$1.96 billion operating budget and a \$542 million capital improvements budget, which includes funds from the County's Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax program.



It addresses community needs like affordable housing and public safety as well as challenges facing county government including hiring and retaining a qualified workforce. After hearing your input, the Board of Commissioners will consider the 2024 budget at our first meeting of the new year on January 2.

Volunteer at Gwinnett's warming stations

Gwinnett County has opened five warming stations for residents to receive temporary, overnight relief from long-term exposure to forecasted temperatures of 35 degrees and below. When activated, warming stations are operational from 6:00pm to 7:00am, allowing residents to warm up, eat a meal, and get some rest. Volunteers are needed to assist staff and organizing check-in materials, greeting participants, monitoring program assets, helping with setup/break down, and other related station tasks. Additional safety cameras coming to Gwinnett

Gwinnett Police is leaning on technology to fight crime with the installation of additional safety cameras across the county. Flock cameras are used to find amber alert victims and missing persons, and they allow officers to get real-time information on where stolen vehicles and suspects of crime are located. The Board of Commissioners recently approved an additional 36 Flock cameras to be installed along state routes. There are more than 7,400 cameras in metro Atlanta, and 835 of those cameras have been placed across Gwinnett since 2020. To learn more,
