
It's May! Prepare for temperatures to heat up, kids to wrap up the school year, and summer vacations to kick off.

# Understanding your Annual Notice of Assessment

The Gwinnett County Board of Assessors mailed approximately 304,000 Annual Notices of Assessment to residential and commercial property owners in April.

An <u>Annual Notice of Assessment</u> is not a tax bill. The notice informs you of the value assessed on your residential or commercial real estate as of January 1, 2023.
