# Board hosts public hearing on proposed 2023 millage rate

The third and final public hearing to share in-person comments the general fund millage rate will occur on **Tuesday**, **July 18 at 11:00am** at the Gwinnett Justice and Administration Center. The proposed millage rate is 6.95 mills, the same as last year. County staff will be available for questions one hour before each public hearing. The Board of Commissioners will consider the millage rates during our meeting on the same day at 2:00pm.

Most property owners who benefit from the <u>Value Offset Exemption</u> won't see an increase in the county government portion of their property taxes. The <u>Homestead Tax Relief Grant</u>, approved by the governor and Georgia General Assembly, will provide additional tax savings for those with a homestead exemption.

#### Care for your lawn and our water resources

During the summer, we crank up our lawnmowers and grass clippings fly. These clippings can be a great source of nutrients for your lawn to help save fertilizer costs, but it's important to keep these clippings out of our storm drains. Anything that enters a storm drain will eventually end up in our waterways. This means that if you dump or blow grass clippings into a storm drain, you could be contributing pollution to our waterways. The nutrients in the grass clippings can lead to excessive growth of algae, which can harm aquatic life in our rivers, lakes, and streams.
