SPLOST Law Overview



State Law - SPLOST

O.C.G.A. §48-8-110 to §48-8-124

- Role of County governing authority
- Capital outlay projects (not operations)
- Uses within boundaries of County
- Countywide Projects



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State Law - SPLOST

O.C.G.A. §48-8-110 to §48-8-124

- Qualified cities
- Allocation of proceeds between County and Cities
- Referendum language

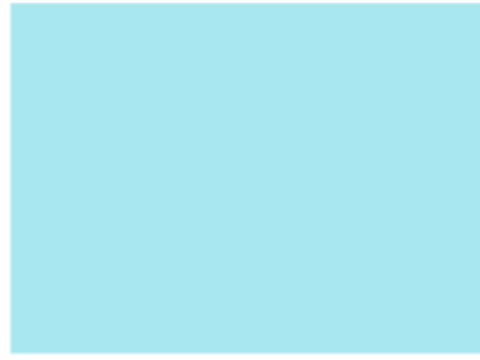


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State Law - SPLOST

O.C.G.A. §48-8-110 to §48-8-124

- State Revenue Department's Fee
- Use of proceeds
- Reporting
- Enforcement



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Eligible SPLOST Projects

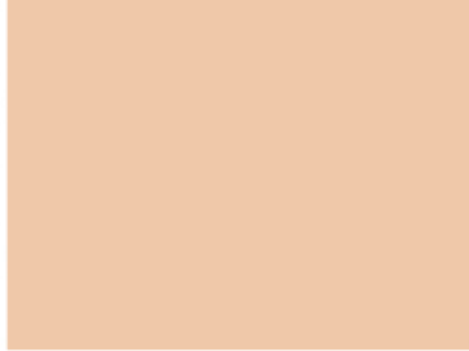


Proceeds may be used for projects located within or outside any incorporated areas of the county.

Proceeds must be used for capital outlay projects as distinguished from current expenditures and ordinary maintenance expenses.



- Transportation projects (roads, bridges, sidewalks, bike paths, storm water and drainage)
- Recreational, Cultural, & Historic Facilities (or combination)
- Public Safety Facilities and Equipment
- Courthouse, administrative bldgs., local or regional jail
- Libraries
- Water and sewer capital projects
- County Health Dept. facility
- Retirement of general obligation debt
- Other



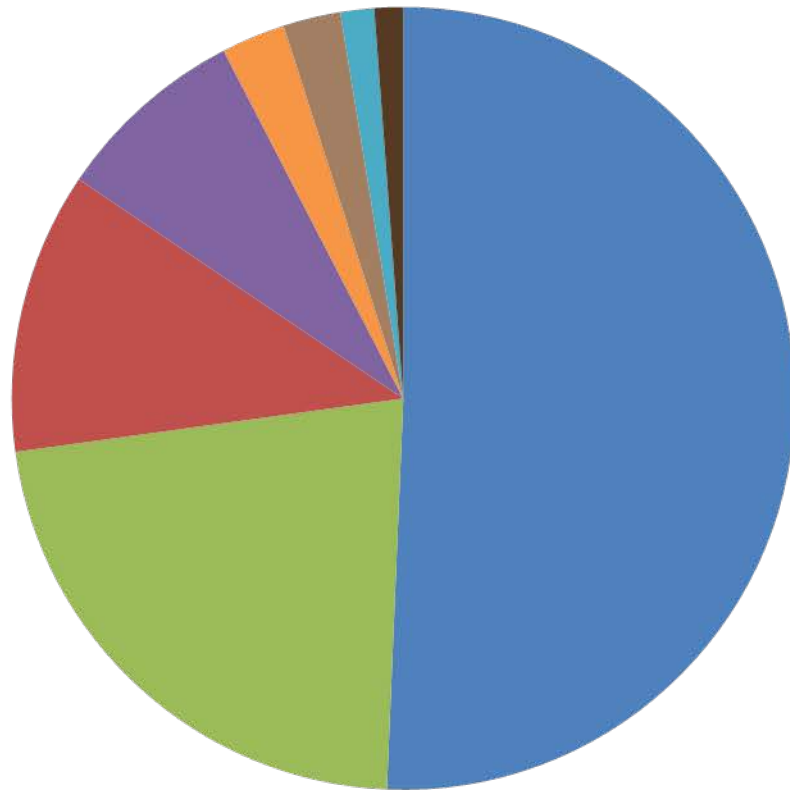

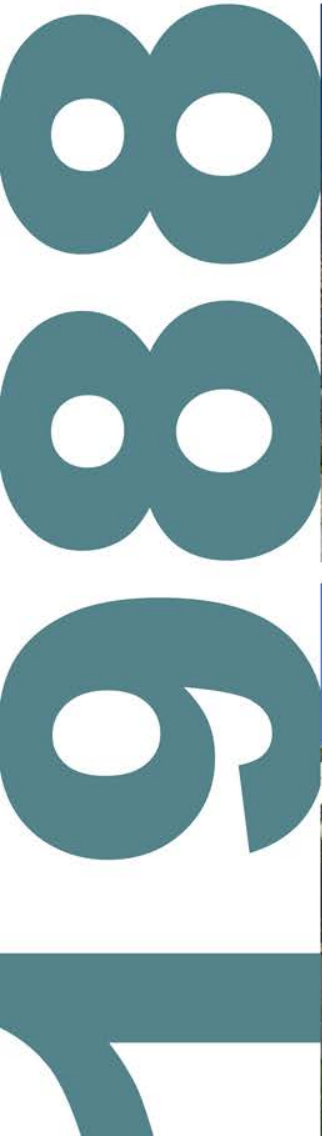

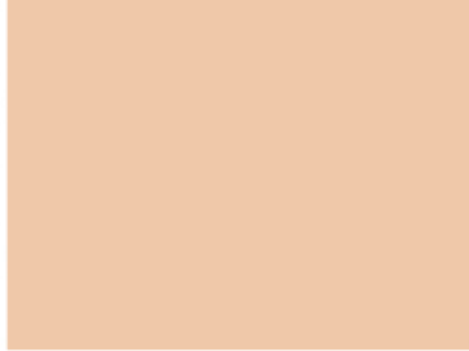
