

State Law -SPLOST



State Law - SPLOST O.C.G.A. §48-8-110 to §48-8-124

- Role of the County governing authority
- Formula for allocation of proceeds between County and Cities
- Intergovernmental Agreement
- Funds capital outlay projects (not operations)



Eligible SPLOST Projects


Proceeds may be used for projects located within or outside any incorporated areas of the county.

Proceeds must be used for capital outlay projects as distinguished from current expenditures and ordinary maintenance expenses.

- Transportation projects (roads, bridges, sidewalks, bike paths, storm water and drainage)
- Recreational, Cultural, & Historic Facilities (or combination)
- Public Safety Facilities and Equipment
- Courthouse, administrative bldgs., local or regional jail
- Libraries
- Water and sewer capital projects
- County Health Dept. facility
- Retirement of general obligation debt




All SPLOST Programs More than \$2.9 Billion in Revenues
