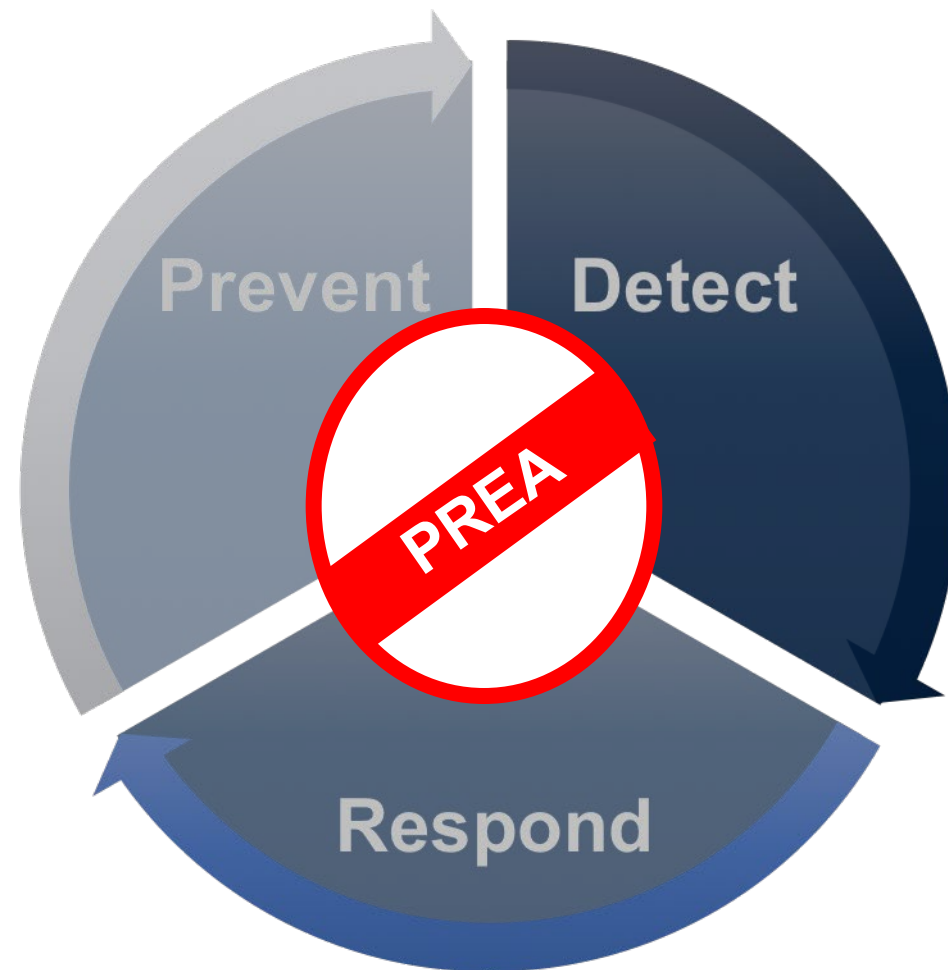

- Heavy Diesel Certification





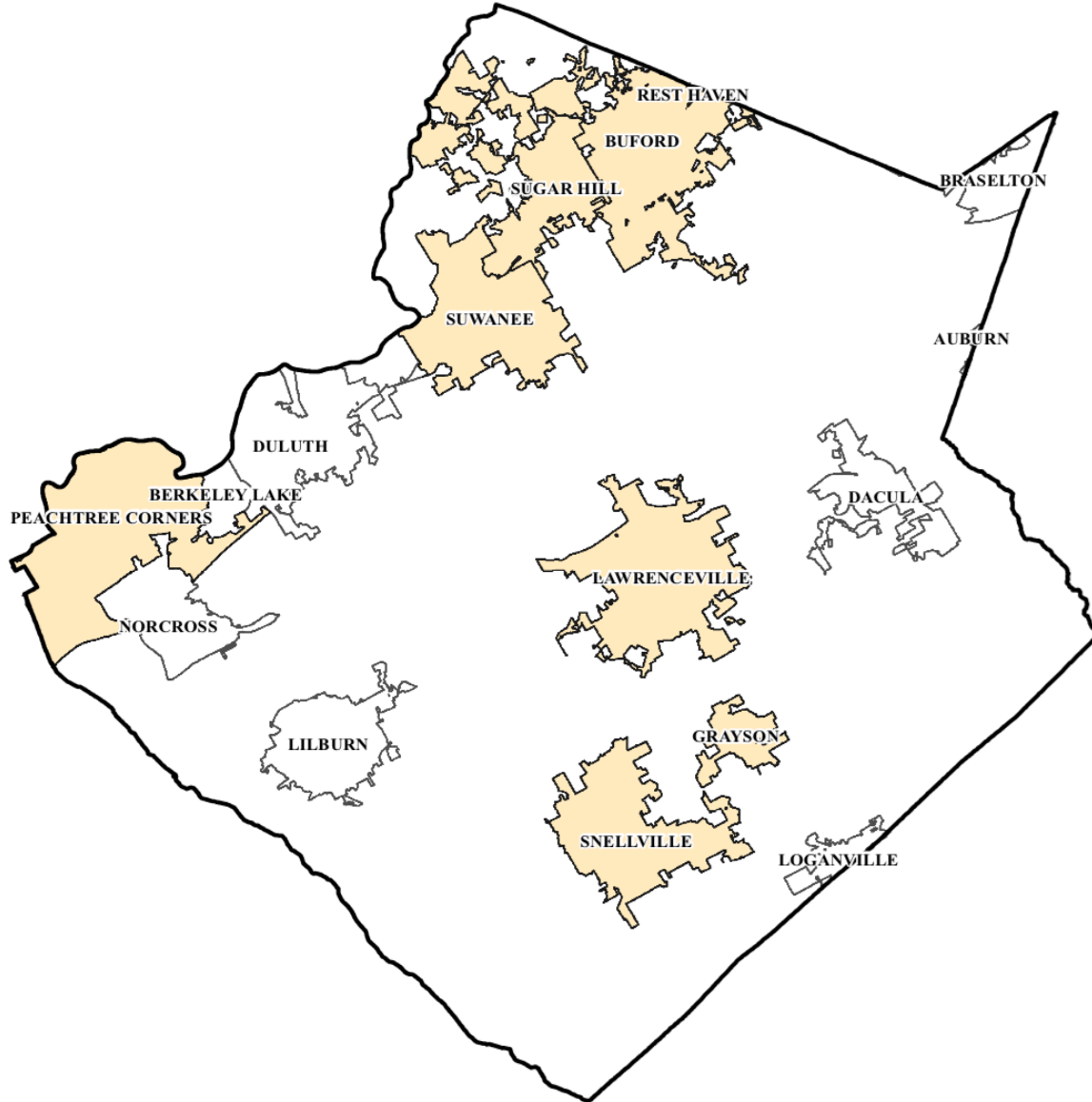

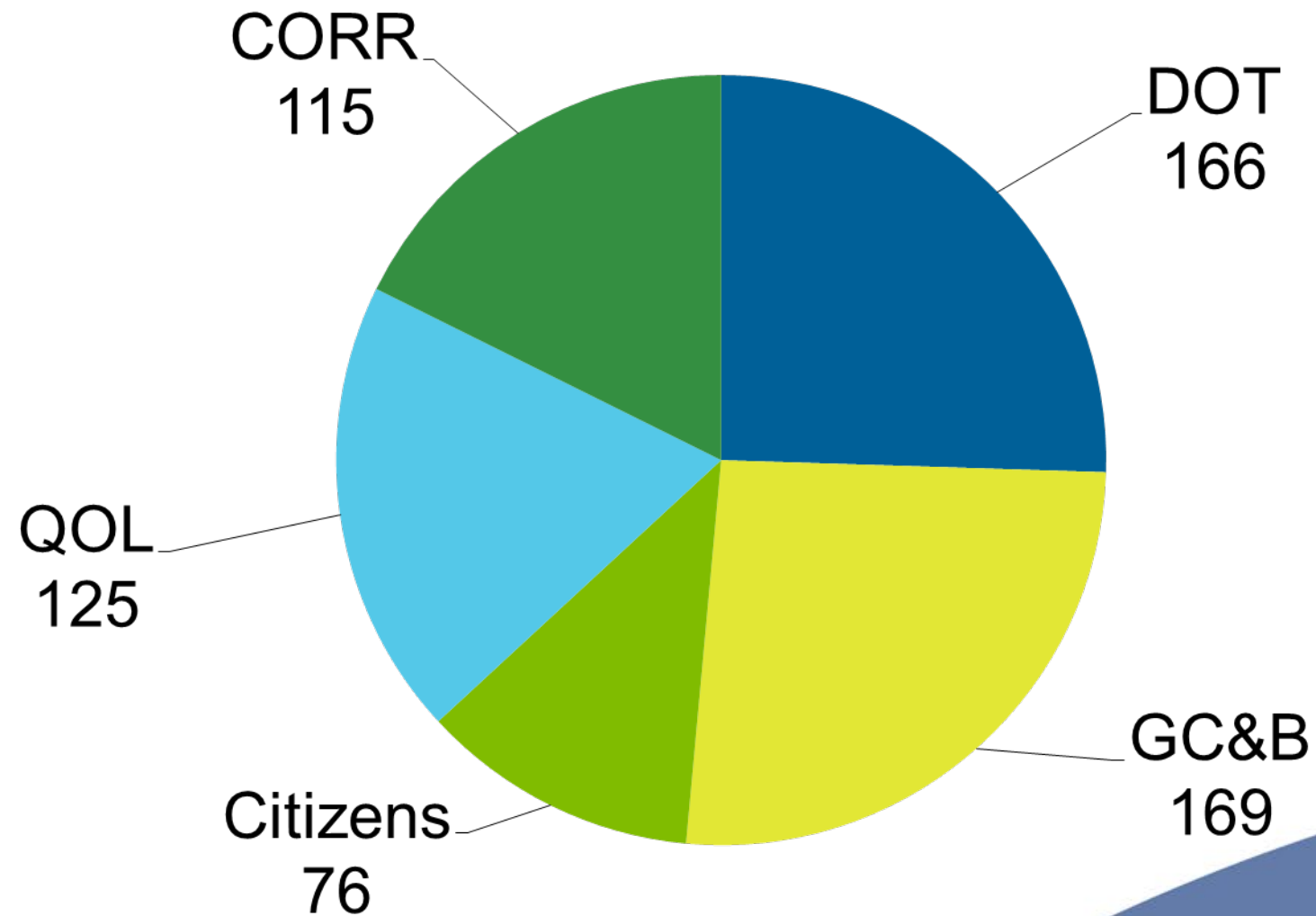

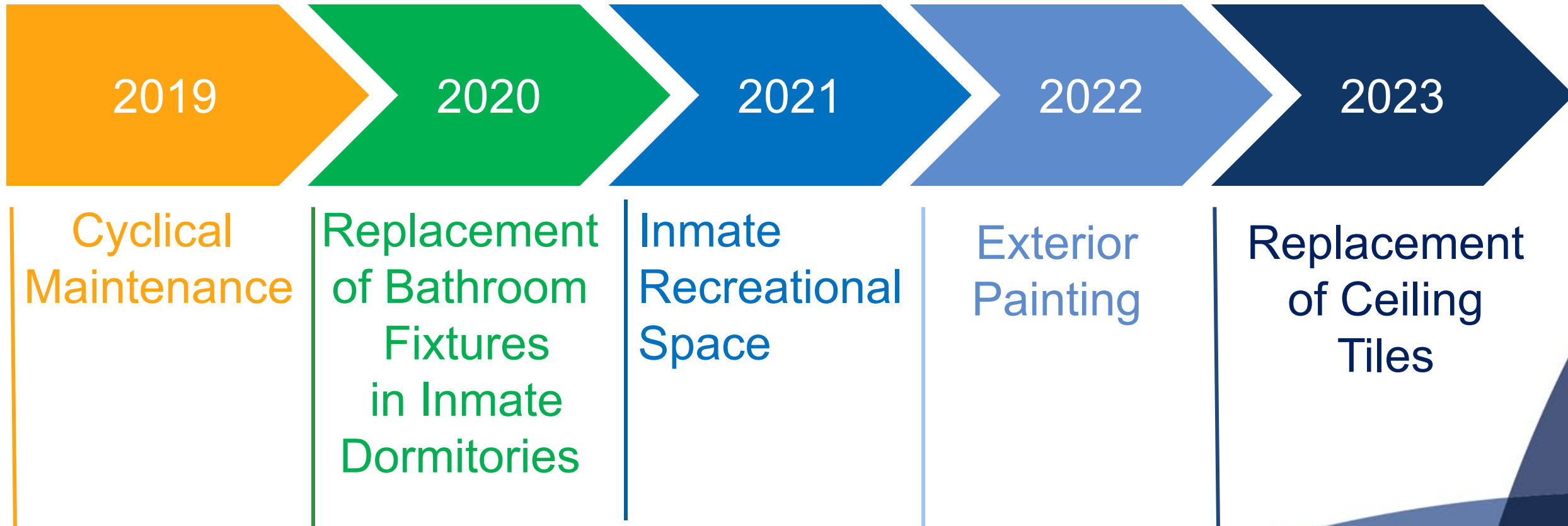
