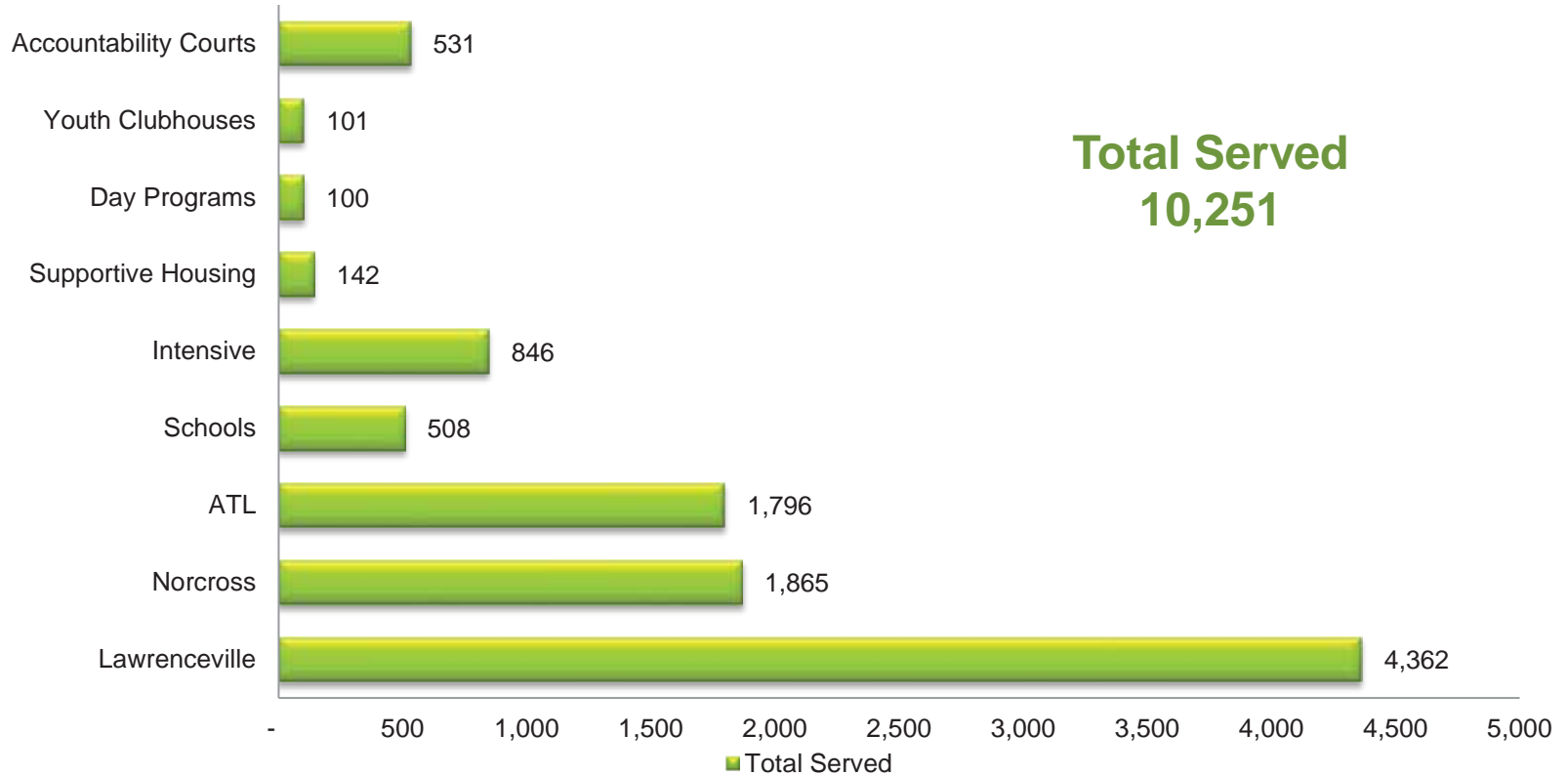

Securing our Safety Net

- In January 2020, View Point Health acquired a private non-profit. The clinic is now called Alianza Terapéutica Latina (ATL) and is View Point Health's outpatient clinic and three youth clubhouses located in Norcross that specialize in linguistic and culturally competent behavioral health services to the Latino Community. **Decision Package Request to add \$366,802 to subsidize the rent at this location**

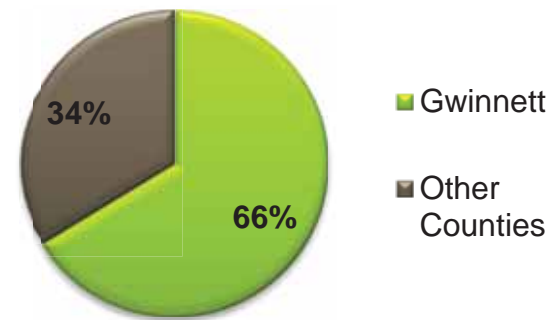


Adult Crisis Stabilization Unit

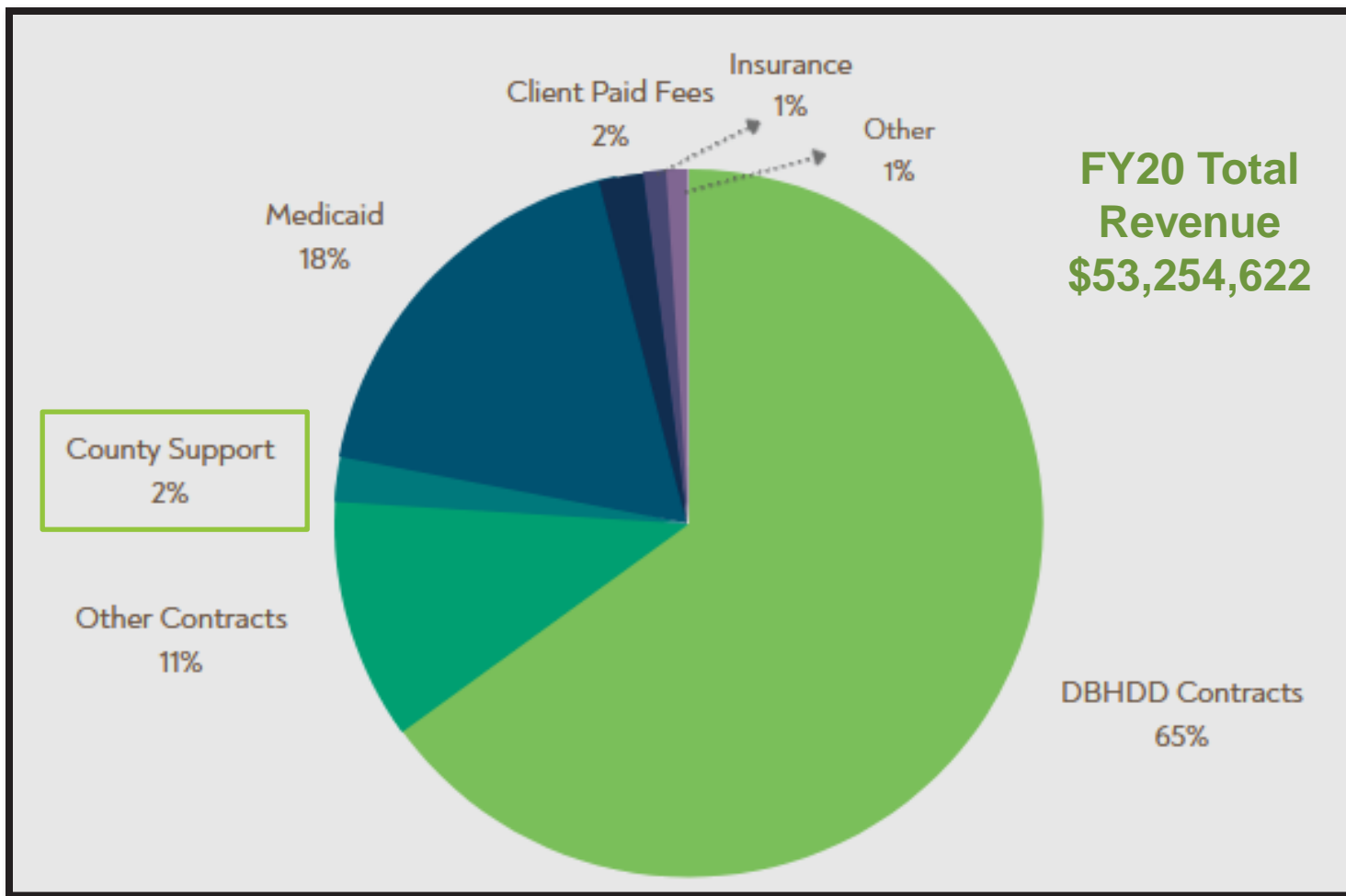


Adult CSU Admissions
