Recorder's Court is a high-volume court established in 1972 to create a system that would effectively and efficiently process the growing number of traffic cases in Gwinnett County.






### **Mandated Functions**

- Record all proceedings of the Recorder's Court
- Collect all costs, fines, and forfeitures and remit these funds by the 15<sup>th</sup> day of the following month to the Gwinnett County Director of Finance or their designee
- Submit dispositions to Georgia Crime Information Center
- Submit dispositions and failure to appear notices to Department of Driver Services
- Retain records according to Georgia Secretary of State
- Submit DUI Publications

- \$71,807 Sheriff's Retirement Fund (O.C.G.A. §§ 47-16-60 and 47-16-61)




## Payment Method

- Approximately 38% of payments are taken electronically




# Citations Filed by Year
