Juvenile Court

- Juvenile Court exercises jurisdiction in cases involving:
 - ✓ DELINQUENT and TRAFFIC under the age of 17; and
 - ✓ DEPENDENT and CHINS offenses under the age of 18.
- Juvenile Court has concurrent jurisdiction with Superior Court involving capital offenses, custody/child support cases, and termination of parental rights.

- 1) Implement Online Portal for traffic cases

 - ✓ Reduces fines/fees and insurance increases for Gwinnett citizens
 - ✓ Creates a continuous revenue stream for the County
- 2) Follow recommendations of state and national nonprofit agencies regarding **best practices** for child welfare cases.
 - ✓ Casey Family Programs (national)
 - ✓ Georgia Supreme Court's Court Improvement Project (state)
 - ✓ Barton Child Law and Policy Center (Emory School of Law)
- 3) Develop new programs and increase participation in evidence-based programs for treatment and rehabilitation.

Decision Package


Requesting funding for 2 full-time Associate Judge positions and 1 full-time Calendar Clerk position


- Will allow Juvenile Court to have a judge on-call 24/7 to make detention/removal decisions

 - ✓ All but 2 counties in Georgia already do this




Requesting funding for 2 full-time Associate Judge positions and 1 full-time Calendar Clerk position
