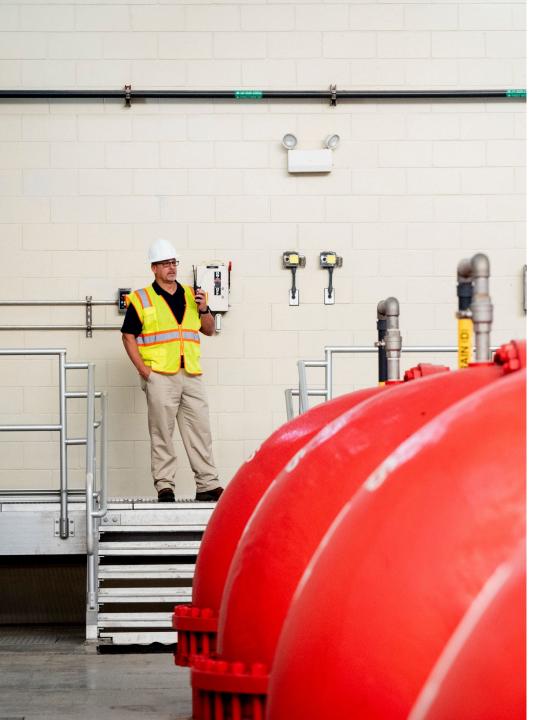

- 44,000 facility assets
 - Current: 7,500 assets assessed per year
 - Goal: 9,000 assets assessed per year
