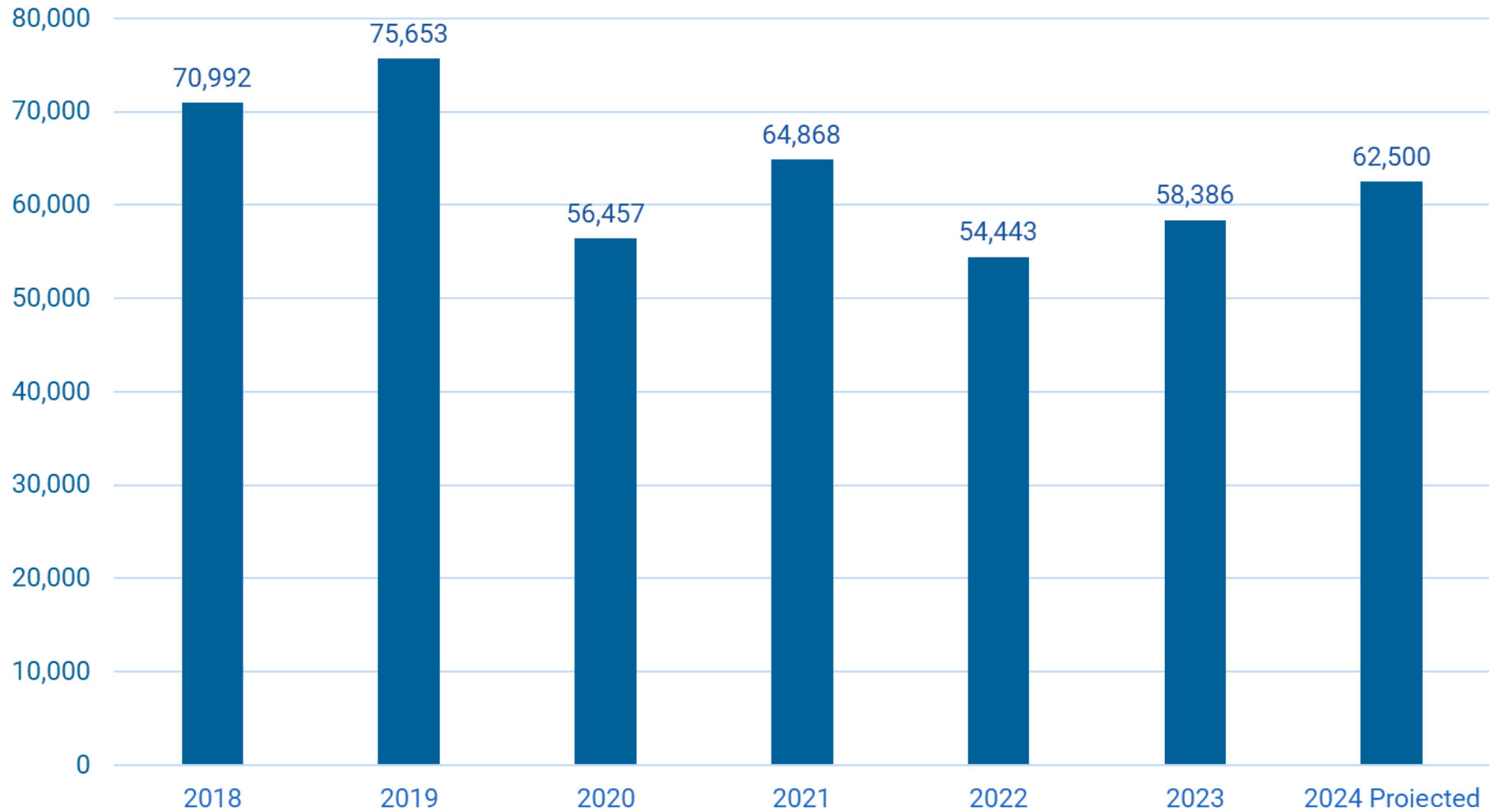

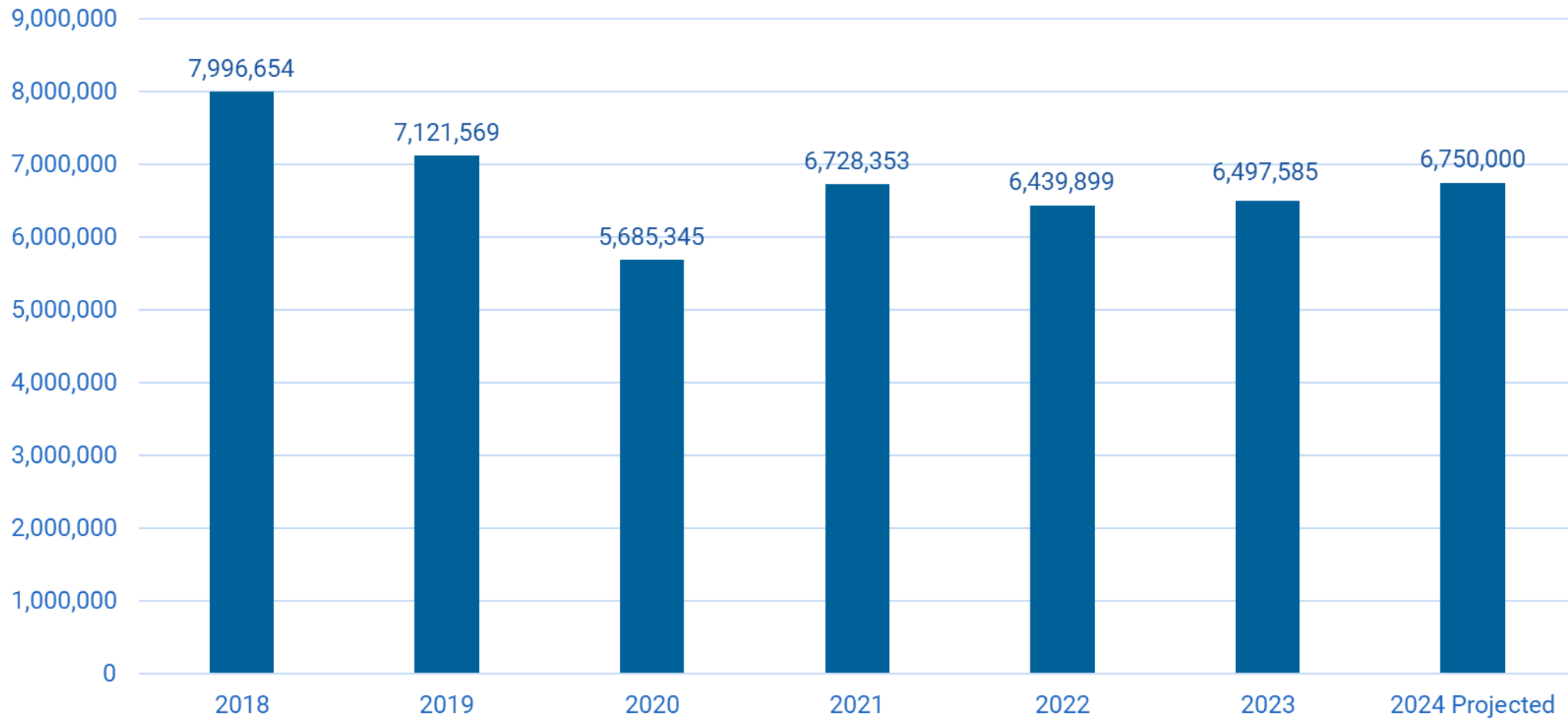

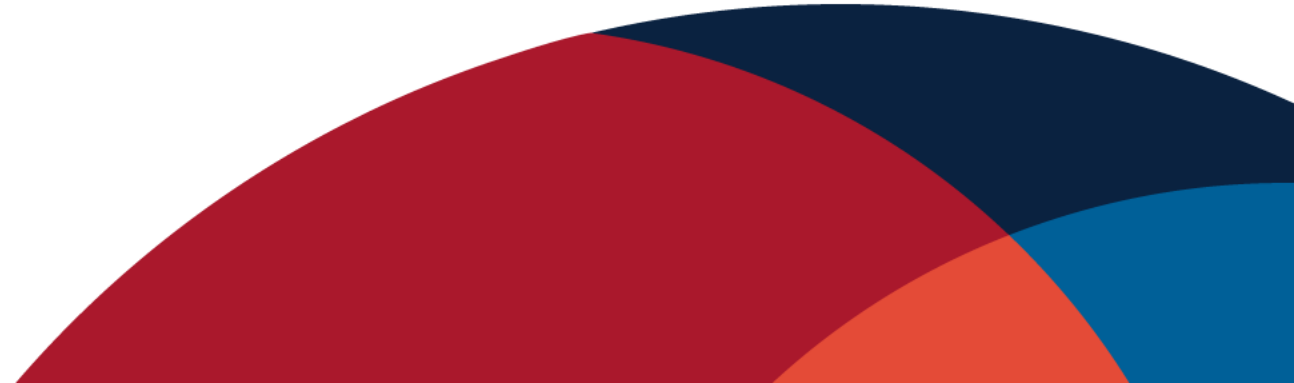


County Initiatives
