Overall Progress Narrative:

Gwinnett County NSP did not generate any program income during this reporting period due to a number of factors. The total amount of Program Income received for NSP1 stands at \$10,646,317.71. Some of the factors that led to Gwinnett County not disposing of any properties this past quarter were due to the entire remaining balance of the grant being obligates to the Oakland Downs project. This project is being move from the NSP1 to the NSP3 grant and will allow for the program to begin acquiring more properties. The local housing market in Gwinnett County is seeing sustained positive growth for the first time in quite a while. This has caused the available housing inventory to shrink along with forcing prices to rise. This has created a new issue within the County as the NSP program tries to strike a balance between acquiring affordable property for rehabilitation and maintaining prices that low-income buyers can afford.

On December 18thHUD released new Income Limits for the NSP program. These new limits fell again and put further strain on the programs low-income set-aside. The program is currently struggling to find low-income buyers who can qualify for mortgages for their finished NSP homes. As the program moves forward it will begin to reevaluate its pricing structure to ensure our homes remain affordable in a difficult market.
