Description

Gwinnett County, in partnership with the Gwinnett Magistrate Court, United Way of Greater Atlanta, and HomeFirst Gwinnett, will build on the success of the Project RESET with Project RESET 2.0, An ERA of Hope.

Project RESET 2.0 will provide rental, utility, and internet service relief for eligible renter households who have become housing insecure as a direct result of the impacts of COVID-19. Payments will be made directly to landlords and utility providers for past-due balances as well as current and future payments.

Eligibility

Households must meet the following criteria:

- Below 80 percent area median income
- Impacted by COVID-19
- Priority given to households at or below 50 percent area median income and those with individuals who have been unemployed more than 90 days at the time of application

Landlords must provide the following documentation:

- Property Ownership/Management
- Executed rental agreement
- Tax ID #

Program Steps

- Tenant or landlord applies online for Project RESET 2.0
- Other party receives automated email regarding filling out their own application
- Project RESET 2.0 staff conducts a completeness check of the application followed by an eligibility review
- Once a household is qualified for the program, payments are scheduled to be made to address the outstanding rental, utility, and/or internet service arrears
