



#### It's always Black Friday at the Animal Welfare Center

Every Friday is Black Friday at the Gwinnett Animal Welfare and Enforcement Center! All mostly black dogs and cats are available at the center for only a \$30 cash veterinarian fee. The fee includes spaying or neutering, the first round of vaccinations, and a microchip.

#### County offices closed for Presidents' Day holiday

All Gwinnett County government offices, with the exception of those operations required for the comfort and safety of the citizens of the County, will be closed Monday, February 18 for the Presidents' Day holiday. County offices will resume normal business hours on Tuesday, February 19. A Magistrate Court judge will be available at the Gwinnett County Detention Center during the holiday.

**Presidents' Day is not a trash and recycling holiday** for solid waste providers in unincorporated Gwinnett County, so trash and recycling collections are scheduled as normal. The Gwinnett County Solid Waste and Recycling Call Center will be closed that day, but hauler call centers will be open. Residents can contact their solid waste hauler with any questions or concerns. Residents who live in a city should contact their city to find out if trash and recycling will be delayed due to the holiday.

**Reduce Your Tax Bill: Apply for Homestead Exemptions**



The best way to reduce your property tax bill is to apply for homestead exemptions. The application deadline is **April 1**. For all exemptions, you must own and occupy the property as your primary residence as of January 1 of the tax year for which application is being made. **Applications for 2013 exemptions will not be accepted after April 1.**

You may apply online at our website or contact the Property Tax Department for an application. If you mail the completed application, we recommend using certified mail; the signed certified signature card, along with a postmark on or before the deadline, will serve as proof of timely application. Once granted, the homestead exemption is automatically renewed each year.

## Helping your house plants survive winter

Houseplants usually require more water during the winter. Indoor heating systems lower the humidity in your home, causing the plants to dry out. The [Gwinnett Cooperative Extension Service](#) recommends keeping an eye on the amount of water your plants are retaining.

To determine if your plants need to be watered, stick your finger at least one inch into the soil. If it's dry, then add room temperature water that's approximately 65 to 75°F. You know you've added the right amount of water when it begins trickling out of the bottom of the pot.

To help maintain humidity, consider grouping plants together in the same area. You can also fill shallow trays with gravel and a couple of inches of water and place your pots in them. Just make sure that your plants are sitting above the water and their roots are not placed in the sitting water.
