Notice of Special Called Meeting

The Gwinnett County Board of Commissioners will hold a public meeting to hear comments on the **Commercialization/Privatization of the Gwinnett County Airport - Briscoe Field on Thursday, April 28 from 7:00pm to 9:00pm**. This meeting will be held at the **12Stone Church**, Central Campus, Main Sanctuary, located at 1322 Buford Drive in Lawrenceville.

This meeting is open to the public. The public is invited to attend and comment on this matter. **Please note that there will be no vote on the issue during this meeting.**

Anyone who intends to address the Board of Commissioners during the meeting must sign in prior to the meeting. Staff will be available at the church to register speakers starting at 5:30pm. Speakers must register as proponents or opponents of commercial operations that include scheduled flights. Speakers will be allotted 3 minutes each. Speakers registered on the proponent list will be called for the first 15 minutes of the comment period, then speakers from the opposition list will be called during the next 15 minutes. That pattern will repeat itself until both sides have exhausted 45 minutes each, with each side having three 15-minute blocks of time. Speakers who intend to use photos, PowerPoint presentations, videos, etc., as a part of their 3-minute presentation must first convert the materials into a format that can be viewed on the church's projection system. In order to accommodate visual support materials, those materials must be hand-delivered to Joe Sorenson at 75 Langley Drive, Lawrenceville, Georgia, by 11:00am on Wednesday, April 27. Anyone who does not wish to speak at the meeting may provide written comments using a computer form available on laptops set up at the church on the night of the forum.
