## Special election voter registration deadline: October 11

A special election will take place on Tuesday, November 8 at your voting precinct. The deadline to

register to vote and be eligible to cast a ballot in this election is Tuesday, October 11.

Visit the [Elections Voter Registration page](#) to download a voter registration application. You can also contact your local public library, public assistance office, recruitment office, schools, and other government offices for a mail-in registration form.

Voters can also request an absentee ballot for the special election beginning October 17. A completed application must first be received before an absentee ballot is issued.
