- Voter registration deadline coming soon

Don't forget to register to vote before October 6

Monday, October 6 is the deadline to register and be eligible to cast a ballot in the November 4 general election, the December 5 state runoff election, and the January 6, 2015, federal runoff election. To register to vote in Georgia, you must be a citizen of the United States, a legal resident of Georgia and of the county in which you wish to vote, and at least 18 years of age by Election Day. You may not register to vote if you are currently serving any sentence imposed by the conviction of a felony or judicially determined to be mentally incompetent.

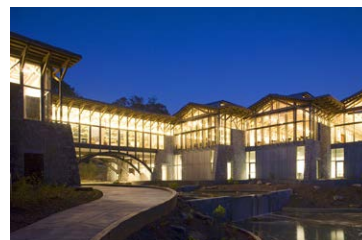
Swap your costume this Halloween

Tech City exhibit opening at the Environmental and Heritage Center

The Tech City exhibit was developed by the Sciencenter and Cornell University with funding from the National Science Foundation to explore the many ways challenges of urban life are met and solved by engineers and the engineering process. This exhibit is the largest traveling exhibit that the Environmental and Heritage Center has hosted since its opening.



The exhibit will feature multiple interactive stations designed to address the common human needs of those who inhabit a typical city. Visitors will get the chance to solve real world problems engineers face every day. The exhibit also features many different fields that engineering encompasses and encourages visitors to consider engineering as a career path.

Poll officials needed for November election

The Voter Registrations and Elections Division needs dedicated citizens to serve as paid poll officials for the upcoming elections. Successful poll officials demonstrate patience, enjoy working with people, take direction well, and are detail oriented. Applicants must be U.S. citizens and residents of Gwinnett County, at least 16 years old, and able to read, write, and speak English. Those who were convicted of a felony involving moral turpitude or judicially determined to be mentally incompetent are not eligible to serve as a poll official.
