

### New Ivy Creek Greenway extension opens

As the leaves begin to fall this season, Gwinnett residents are getting outside to walk and run the trail systems found throughout the county. Walkers and runners now have a new trail to experience along the Ivy Creek Greenway.



The newest section of the Ivy Creek Greenway adds 1.5 miles of trail to the existing walking and biking path located near the Gwinnett Environmental and Heritage Center and the Mall of Georgia in Buford. This new section includes two boardwalks, an overlook, a 270-foot long cable-stayed bridge, a nature observation trail, and a restroom building.

The trail can be accessed from the EHC at 2020 Clean Water Drive in Buford. Long range plans call for the greenway to connect to an existing section at George Pierce Park, creating seven miles of biking and walking opportunities. The Ivy Creek Greenway is open from dawn to dusk every day of

the week.

Funding for the \$2.2 million project comes from a \$1 million state grant from the Federal Highway Administration's Transportation Enhancement Program and the County's SPLOST program. Registered voters may [request an absentee ballot](#) by mail or cast their ballot in person from October 13 - 31, Monday through Friday from 8:00am to 5:00pm at the Gwinnett County Voter Registrations and Elections Office, located at 455 Grayson Highway in Lawrenceville.



There are several other options to cast your ballot in advance of the November 4 election:

**Saturday voting:** October 18 and 25 at the Voter Registrations and Elections office from 9:00am to 4:00pm

**Satellite voting:** October 25 from 9:00am to 4:00pm and October 27 - 31 from 9:00am to 7:00pm; visit the [Polling Place Locator webpage](#) for locations.

Voters will be able to view the results of the November 4 election, including advance voting results, on the [Secretary of State's Georgia Elections Results webpage](#) on election night.
