Gwinnett Commission Chairman Charlotte Nash formally presented her [proposed fiscal year 2013 budget](#) to the Board of Commissioners during a briefing on Tuesday,



November 27. The proposed budget totals \$1.3 billion, which is 8.5 percent lower than this year's \$1.43 billion.
