Rain Garden Workshop

April 17 from 4:00pm to 5:30pm. Rain gardens are attractive and functional landscape features that require less maintenance and fewer chemicals than the typical lawns. They capture runoff from impervious areas such as roofs and driveways and allow it to soak slowly into the ground. Rain gardens also help preserve nearby streams and lakes by filtering pollutants and reducing the volume of runoff. This Department of Water Resources workshop will teach you how to choose a location and install the garden, how to select plants, and how rain gardens help reduce water bills and protect waterways from nonpoint source pollution.
