Attend a Piedmont Pathway Study meeting

Learn about the 2023 Piedmont Pathway Study and share your thoughts on the development of the trail on **Thursday**, **February 16 from 6:30pm to 8:30pm at Best Friend Park**. If you're unable to attend, you can take the survey at GwinnettCounty.com/PathwayStudy.

As part of the Core Trail system and the Gwinnett Countywide Trails Master Plan, the 28-mile, cross-county trail is designed to provide multiple social, economic, and environmentally sustainable benefits. The Piedmont Pathway will also address connectivity needs in Gwinnett and provide alternate modes of transportation for residents and visitors.



Share your ideas for transit in Gwinnett



Gwinnett continues to develop its effort in reimagining the future of public transit with a series of <u>Ride Gwinnett Idea</u> <u>Labs</u>. The idea labs are an opportunity for transit riders, residents, and stakeholders to work with the County on its Transit Development Plan.

Launched in the spring of 2022, Gwinnett's <u>Transit</u> <u>Development Plan</u> is evaluating both present and future transit needs and services provided by regional partners, including the Atlanta-Region Transit Link Authority and Xpress.

Take the Comprehensive Human Services Needs Assessment Survey

Gwinnett County is extending the deadline on its <u>Human Services Needs Assessment survey</u>. As a part of this process, Health Management Associates is distributing <u>a survey</u> to help understand the health and well-being of our community and be able to allocate resources to assist those in need.

The <u>survey</u> will take approximately 10 minutes to complete and will be available until **Tuesday**, **February 28**. It is also available in Spanish, Vietnamese, Korean, and Chinese. Health Management Associates will combine the results of this survey with information collected from other activities to better meet the needs of Gwinnett residents.

You may qualify for a \$30 monthly discount on your home or mobile internet service through the Federal Communications Commission Affordable Connectivity Program. Gwinnett County is encouraging eligible residents to claim this benefit and start saving on internet service.
