Park Hours Sunrise - Sunset, unless otherwise posted

Alcoholic Beverages Prohibited

Park or Drive in Designated Areas

Littering Prohibited

All animals must be under physical control with leash or lead line at all times.

All riders, skaters, etc. should use proper safety equipment at all times. (helmets, guards, pads, etc.)

Swimming and the use of Inflatable Flotation Devices Prohibited

Personal Watercraft Prohibited

Horses Allowed on Marked Trail (ONLY East Mulberry Trail, Equestrian Trailers @ Mineral Springs Entry Only)

Individual Camping Prohibited

Fires Prohibited Except in Grills

All Weapons Prohibited

Feeding, Harassing, Hunting and Trapping of Wildlife Prohibited
