(Overall, 27% of County Residents are "Not Familiar at All" with Park Recreation Resources)

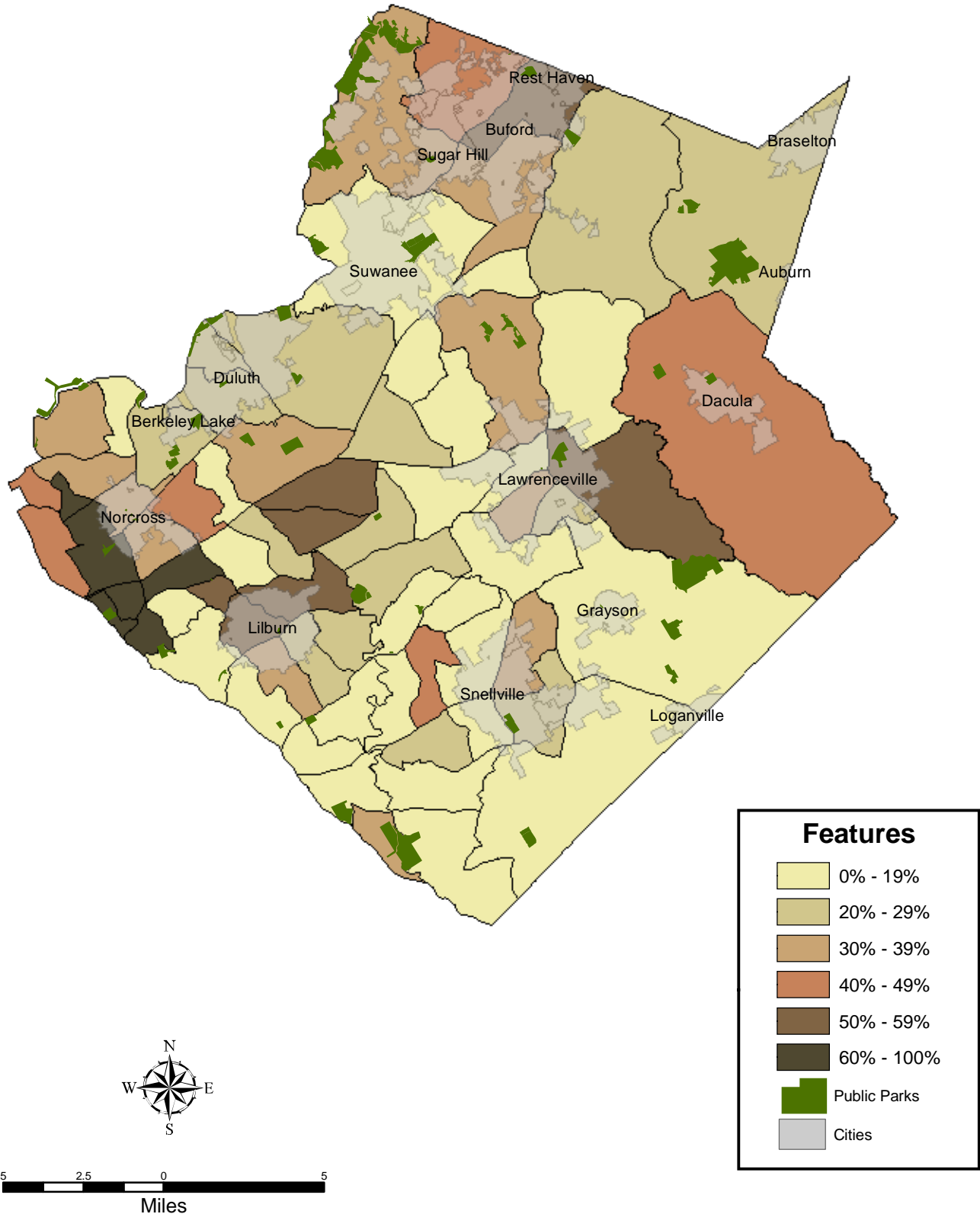

(Overall, 39% of All Adults Surveyed Said the County Should Provide More Recreational Facilities)

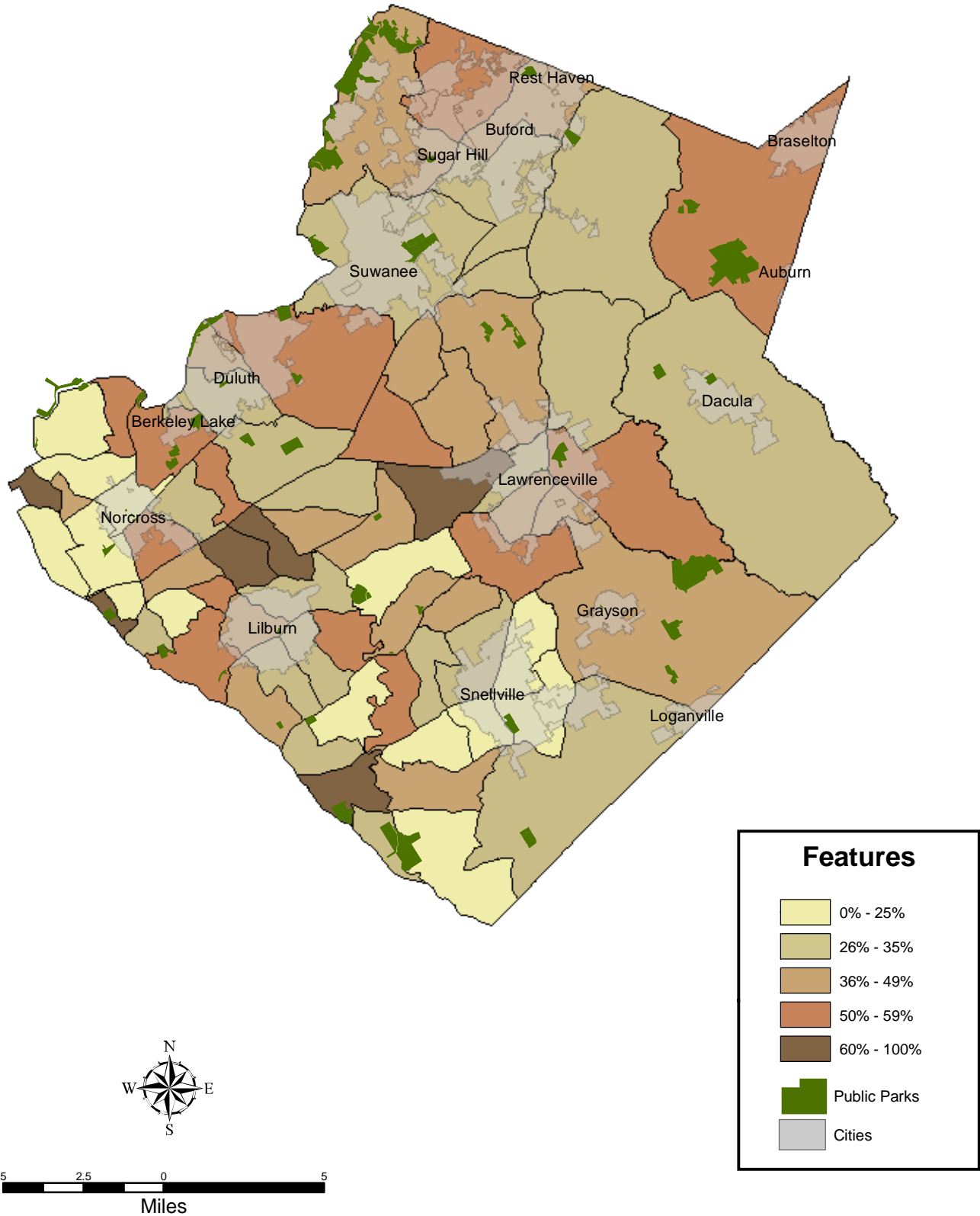

(Overall, 74% of All Adults Surveyed Said They have Utilized a County Park in the Past Year)

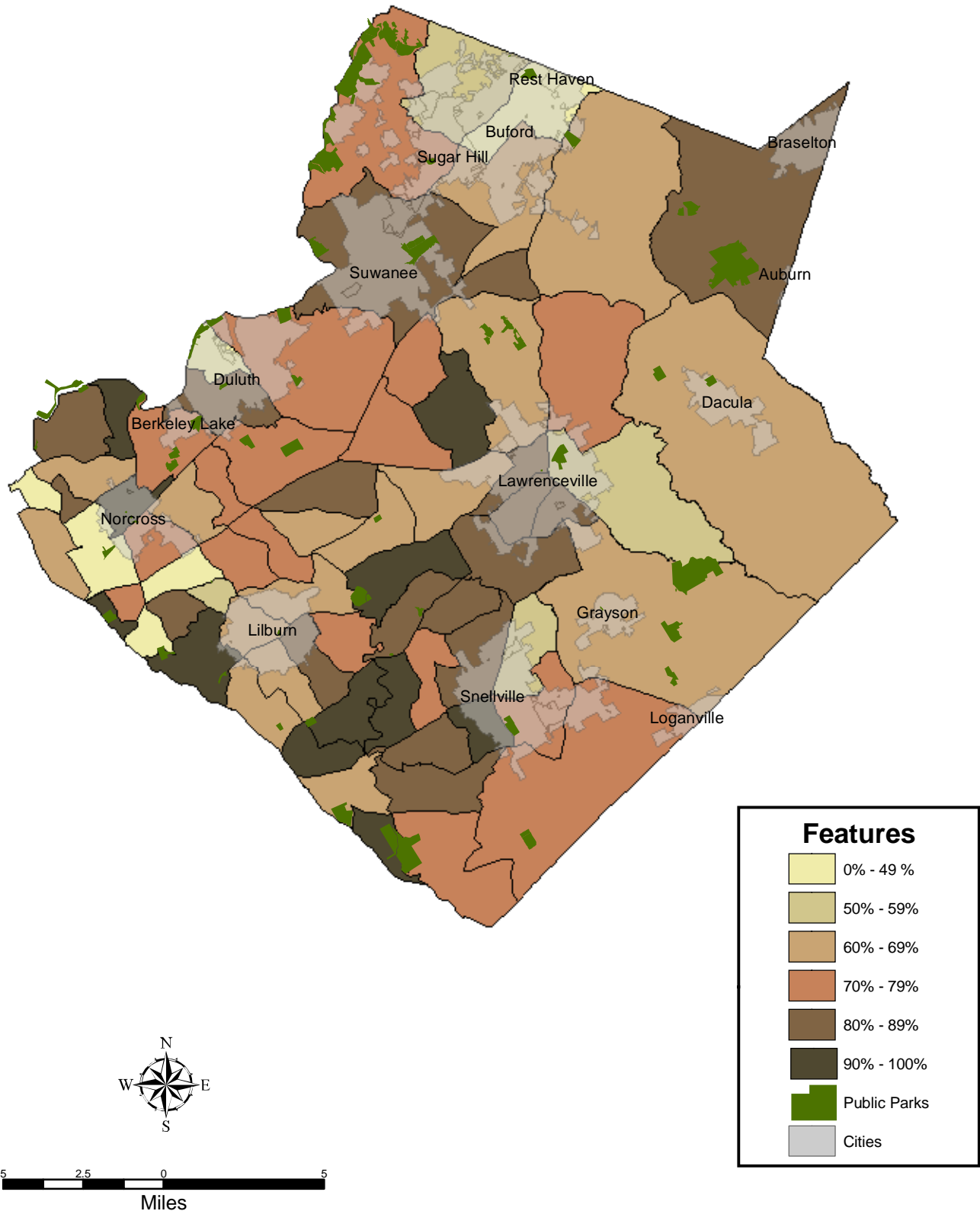

(Overall, 84% of All Adults Surveyed Said the County Should Continue to Use SPLOST to Fund These Efforts)

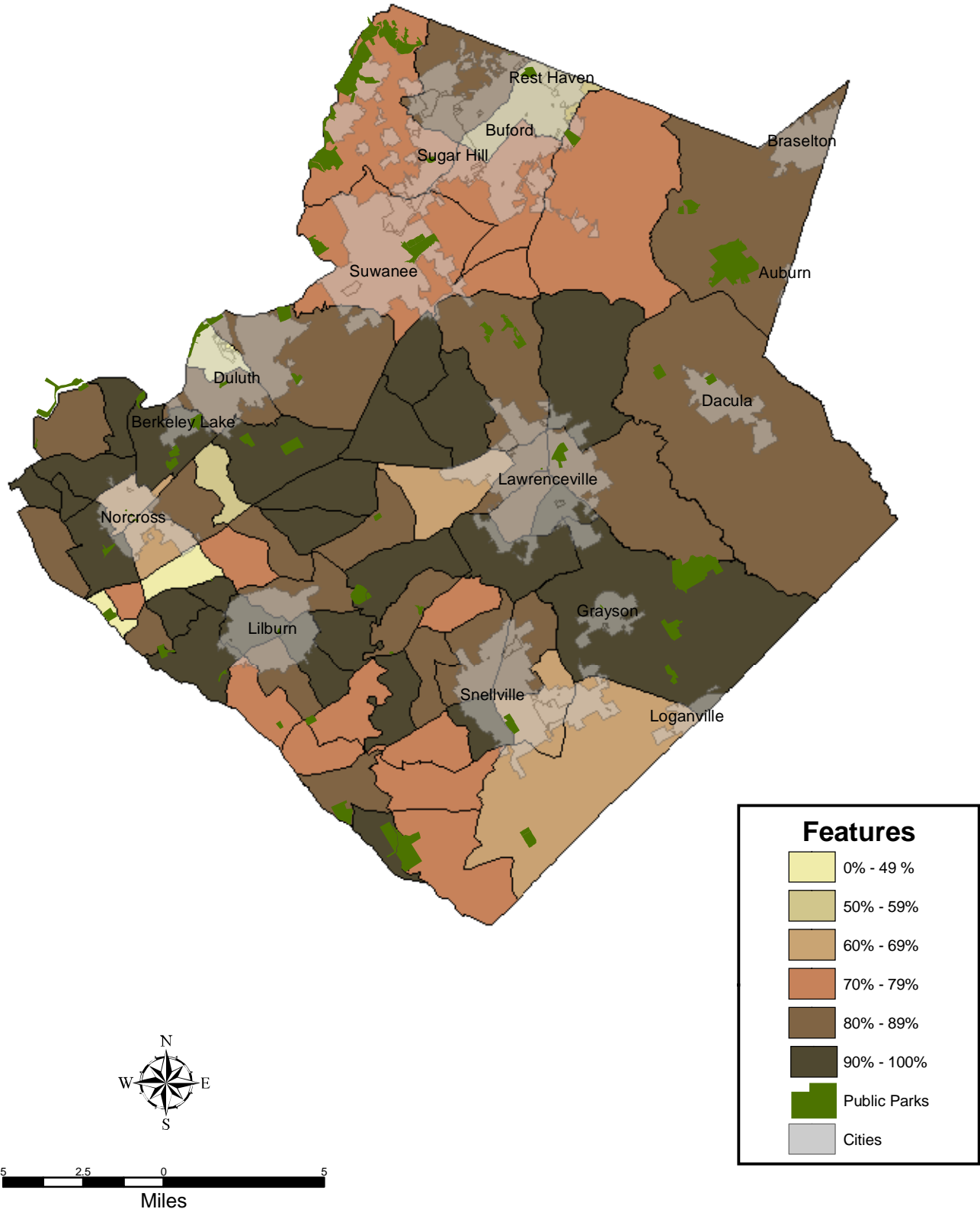
