



GWINNETT COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SUBSECTION 86-111(1)

OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF GWINNETT COUNTY

BE IT ORDAINED that Subsection 86-111(1) of the Code of Ordinances of Gwinnett County is hereby amended by striking said Subsection in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- (1) Non-illuminated temporary freestanding signs (excluding banners which are regulated in accordance with Section 86-109). For each residential or non-residential lot, the quantity of these signs shall be limited to either one sign that is 16 square feet in area or up to four signs with each of these signs limited to a maximum of four square feet in area. In addition, each sign shall not be greater than eight feet above the grade level of the adjacent street to which the sign is located or three feet above ground level, whichever is greater. These signs shall not be located within the public street right-of-way and shall be no closer than ten feet to the back curb of a public roadway.

Any and all provisions of the Code of Ordinances of Gwinnett County in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.


