

CTP PROJECT TYPE DESCRIPTIONS

INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS

These may require more right-of-way for new turn lanes, widened shoulders, roundabouts, signals, realignment, and/or multi-modal improvements to enhance safety & operations.

NEW ROADWAY CONNECTIONS

New road connections may enhance traffic flow by providing more choices or relieving capacity issues on key corridors & shortening the distance people need to travel by car, bike, or on foot.

ROADWAY & BRIDGE MAINTENANCE

Regular repair of existing transportation infrastructure, such as roads & bridges, ensures the County's current assets can continue to be used in the future.

ROADWAY SAFETY & ALIGNMENT

Intersections and corridors identified as having a higher risk of crashes may benefit from enhancements such as widened shoulders, guardrail/signage installation, and additional turn lanes.

MAJOR ROAD CAPACITY

Roadway widening to add travel lanes along existing key routes may enhance traffic flow and reduce congestion.

TRAIL & SIDEWALK CONNECTIONS

New sidewalks and/or trails may provide better connectivity to key destinations and activity centers for people who are walking or biking.

TRANSIT

Transit service additions or improvements may result in more efficient and more direct public transportation options throughout the County.
