Change to Commuter Route 110

To better serve our Emory University and Center for Disease Control riders, Gwinnett County Transit has added earlier morning departure times to Route 110 as of **November 12**. From **Sugarloaf Mills Park and Ride**, Route 110 now departs at **5:20am** and **5:50am** in addition to later times. From **Indian Trail Park and Ride**, Route 110 departs at **5:35am** and **6:05am** in addition to later times. For more
