Super Bowl LIII Service Changes - REVISED

Beginning **January 28, 2019** through **February 4, 2019**, the City of Atlanta will implement lane restrictions and/or road closures in the downtown area for Super Bowl events. Lane restrictions are as follows:

- **No PM pick up at Baker Street and Peachtree Street (SunTrust Plaza)** until February 4, 2019
- GCT will board all passengers for the above stop at the **Civic Center MARTA Station**
- **AM drop off will not be impacted**



Please keep in mind that the City of Atlanta Police Department has the final say in command and control of downtown traffic operations. In the event there are unannounced road closures and the buses must deviate from our normal routing, GCT will have transportation supervisors in the area for the entire week to help direct passengers to alternative bus stops. Expect delays due to heavy traffic in the downtown area.

Upcoming Transit Contract Referendum Open Houses



Gwinnett County residents will go to the polls March 19 to vote on a [contract](#) for the provision of expanded transit services. If the referendum passes, Gwinnett's transit system and services will expand based on Gwinnett's transit plan and its contract with MARTA. The expansion will be funded through a one-cent sales tax for transit.

The contract provides control to Gwinnett over funds, expenditures, projects, and services. It requires Gwinnett funds to be spent for the benefit of Gwinnett. It sets

Gwinnett's transit plan, Connect Gwinnett, as the source of transit projects. It also provides Gwinnett with three seats on the MARTA board.

To better educate the community on the upcoming transit contract referendum, Gwinnett County will be hosting open houses over the next few weeks.

Gwinnett residents will have the opportunity to learn what the [Connect Gwinnett Transit Plan](#) and the proposed [MARTA contract](#) entails, and ask questions to better understand how it will impact them, if passed. Upcoming dates include:

Ways to vote in the Transit Contract Referendum

Voters will have multiple opportunities to cast their ballot in the transit referendum on **Tuesday, March 19**. **February 19** is the last day to register to vote and/or update your

registration record for this election.

Advance in-person voting at the Main Elections Office runs from **7:00am to 7:00pm** daily from **February 25 to March 15**, including Saturdays and Sundays. The Main Elections Office is located at **455 Grayson**



Highway, Suite 200 in **Lawrenceville**. From **March 4 to March 15**, voters may cast their ballots at one of seven satellite locations from **7:00am to 7:00pm** daily, including Saturdays and Sundays. The seven satellite locations can be found at www.gwinnettelelections.com. Voters can request an absentee ballot through **Friday, March 15**. A completed application must be received before an absentee ballot can be issued. On **Election Day, March 19**, voters must go to their assigned polling location. To find your assigned polling location or to check the status of your voter registration, visit the [Georgia Secretary of State's website](#) or call the Elections Office at **678.226.7210**.

Los votantes tendrán múltiples oportunidades para emitir su voto en el Referéndum del Contrato de Transporte el **Martes 19 de Marzo**. El **19 de Febrero** es el último día para inscribirse para votar y/o actualizar su historial de inscripción electoral para esta elección.

La votación adelantada en persona es en la Oficina Principal de Elecciones todos los días de **7:00am a 7:00pm**, del **25 de Febrero al 15 de Marzo**, incluidos los Sábados y Domingos. La Oficina Principal de Elecciones está ubicada en **455 Grayson Highway, Suite 200 en Lawrenceville**. Desde el **4 de Marzo hasta el 15 de Marzo**, los votantes pueden emitir su voto en una de las siete ubicaciones satélite desde las **7:00am a 7:00pm** todos los días, incluidos los Sábados y Domingos. Las siete ubicaciones satélite se pueden encontrar en www.gwinnettelelections.com. Los votantes pueden solicitar una boleta de voto ausente hasta el **Viernes 15 de Marzo**. Se debe recibir una solicitud completa antes de que se pueda emitir una boleta de voto ausente.
