We are celebrating **A Time for Transit** this July!





Did you know that there are **four Gwinnett County Public Library branches** on GCT routes? The **Norcross, Peachtree Corners, Lilburn, and Lawrenceville** locations are on local routes **10, 20, 35, and 40**, making it easier for patrons to access books, computers, movies, and magazines. The library also offers English courses, STEM programs for children and adults, entrepreneur programs, and career online high school diploma programs, and more.

You are eligible for a free library card if you are a Gwinnett County resident, Gwinnett County Government employee, city government employee within Gwinnett County, Gwinnett County Public School employee, Georgia Gwinnett College student, staff, or faculty member, or Gwinnett Technical College student, staff, or faculty member.
