## What's new?

### Reduced bus schedules to Atlanta return



As of Monday, June 1, Gwinnett County Transit will run commuter express bus service to downtown Atlanta on a reduced schedule. Service to downtown Atlanta was temporarily suspended on April 23 in response to COVID-19. Fare box collection will continue to be temporarily suspended. ### Passenger limit on buses continue

On Monday, June 1, Gwinnett County Transit is temporarily restricting the number of passengers on local buses to 15 to practice social distancing between bus drivers and passengers. Once a local bus reaches its 15 passenger capacity, it will display "Bus Full. Please wait for the next bus" until there is room on the bus. We are also setting the limit of passengers on commuter buses to 14.

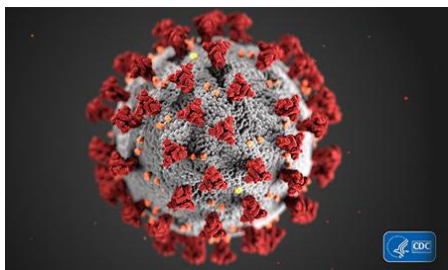
