Change to Local Route 40

To better serve the Gwinnett Justice and Administration Center and its visitors, Gwinnett County Transit is moving its **inbound** bus stops to the building's front entrance and the intersection of Constitution Boulevard and Langley Drive. This change will take effect on **November 12**.

The Gwinnett Justice and Administration Center (except offices that maintain the safety and comfort of Gwinnett County) will be closed on this day to recognize the Veterans Day holiday. Routes 10A/B (weekday service), 30 (Saturday service), and 110 have been updated for November 12, 2018 as well. For more information on the route updates, please visit Routes and Schedules.

Beginning this month, Gwinnett County Transit will have changes to service due to holidays. On **November 22**, Thanksgiving Day, there will be **no service**. On the following day, **November 23**. Local, Paratransit, and Microtransit Service will be in operation, while Commuter Service will **not** run for the day. On **November 12**, the day after Veterans Day, all service will run as usual. After just a month and a half in service, Gwinnett County Microtransit ridership has risen to 329 in one day! This is a record high in comparison to other Microtransit pilots, according to TransLoc, our pilot's technology provider.
