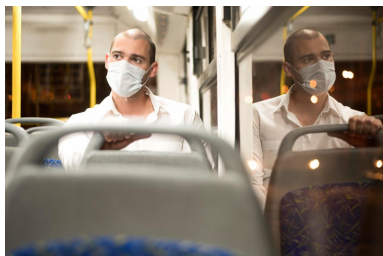
Stay tuned in with Gwinnett County Transit

Face mask requirement extended through April 18



While Gwinnett County Chairwoman Hendrickson's mask [mandate](#) for County facilities was allowed to expire on February 25, GCT passengers are required to wear a face mask on all buses through **April 18, 2022**. This is in accordance with recent [TSA](#) and [FTA](#) guidance for travelers using public transit.
