

WATER ON WHEELS REQUIREMENTS



Thank you for your interest in Gwinnett County Department of Water Resources free, in-school education program, Water on Wheels! The following list describes the requirements of the program.

- The coordinating teacher must reserve an unused room for the days that our educators will be visiting. If there is furniture in the room, our educator will arrange them as needed and put them back when the program is done.
 - 1st grade: No room requirements; students can sit on the floor
 - 3rd grade: Room needs a projector; students will eventually sit in groups either at tables or on the floor if furniture is not available
 - 5th grade: Room needs a projector; students will sit in groups. Tables and chairs are needed
- Our programs require time to break down and set up, we will require a minimum of 10 minutes between classes to prepare for the next one. We will work with you to create a schedule that avoids important periods throughout the day such as lunch, specials, or recess as needed.
 - 1st grade: program runs for ~45 minutes
 - 3rd grade: program runs for ~50 minutes
 - 5th grade: program runs for ~50 minutes
- The DWR education team will only be able to see up to 3 or 4 classes each day. Each “class” can only contain up to 30 students. We do not have the resources for our activities to accommodate additional students per class.
- If we are visiting for multiple days, we will pack up our supplies and leave them in the corner of our reserved room overnight. If the room will be used for other groups on the days it is reserved for us, please inform us as soon as possible.
- The educator assigned to your school will arrive a half hour prior to the first lesson and will ask at the front desk for directions to the assigned classroom. Please let your front desk know about the program and reserved room.
- Teachers will bring their class to our reserved room on a rotating basis. Arriving late may cause the class to miss part or all of the program. We cannot guarantee that we will have time to make up missed programs.
- Teachers must remain in the room with their students as the program is presented.

If you have any questions or concerns about our program and the requirements, please bring them up as soon as possible to avoid potential issues while we are visiting.
