WHEREAS effective March 14, 2020 the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Georgia has also determined that a statewide judicial emergency exists and which order declares an emergency extending to April 13, 2020. That order issued by the Chief Justice is also hereby incorporated herein.

Therefore, pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 38-3-61, The Honorable Chief Judge George F.

Hutchinson, III of the Superior Court of Gwinnett County, Gwinnett Judicial Circuit DOES


HEREBY ORDER AND DECLARES AGAIN the existence of a Judicial Emergency in the

Gwinnett Judicial Circuit. The nature of this emergency is the continued transmission of

Coronavirus/COVID-19 throughout Gwinnett County and the potential infection of those who

are required to appear in our courts and interact with large groups due to jury service, including grand jury service and non-essential calendars. Thus, the undersigned hereby extends the duration of the *Order Declaring Judicial Emergency* filed on March 13, 2020 affecting all courts and clerk's offices in Gwinnett County until April 13, 2020 at 11:59 PM. Should the Statewide Judicial Emergency be extended by the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court, this emergency declaration shall also be extended to the same extent as the statewide order but for no more time than that allowed by O.C.G.A. § 38-3-61(b).

IT IS ORDERED that the Sheriff of Gwinnett County shall post this Order on his public notification site and in the courthouses;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the undersigned shall immediately notify and serve Chief Justice Harold D. Melton of the Supreme Court with a copy of this Order, such service to be accomplished via email to Tee Barnes, the Clerk of the Supreme Court of Georgia, at barnest@gasupreme.us;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the undersigned shall immediately notify and serve a copy of the order on the judges and clerks of all courts sitting within the jurisdictions affected and on the clerks of the Georgia Court of Appeals and the Georgia Supreme Court, such service to be accomplished through reasonable means to assure expeditious receipt; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the undersigned shall give notice of the issuance of this Order to the affected parties, counsel for the affected parties, and the public.
