

NOTICE OF PROPERTY TAX INCREASE

The Gwinnett County Board of Commissioners has tentatively adopted a millage rate which will require an increase in property taxes by 14.16 percent.

All concerned citizens are invited to the public hearing on this tax increase to be held at the Gwinnett Justice and Administration Center's Auditorium, 75 Langley Drive, Lawrenceville, Georgia on July 11, 2022 at 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m.

Times and places of additional public hearings on this tax increase are at the Gwinnett Justice and Administration Center's Auditorium, 75 Langley Drive, Lawrenceville, Georgia, on August 1, 2022 at 6:30 p.m.

This tentative increase will result in a millage rate of 6.950 mills, an increase of 0.862 mills. Without this tentative tax increase, the millage rate will be no more than 6.088 mills. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of \$375,000 is approximately \$120.68 and the proposed tax increase for non-homestead property with a fair market value of \$600,000 is approximately \$206.88.
