- VII. Approval to renew OS034-18, provision of products and services for DeZurik valves on an annual contract (December 19, 2019 through December 18, 2020), with Eco-Tech, Inc., base amount \$700,000.00.
- VIII. Approval to renew RP018-18, landfill disposal of bio-solids and grit and screenings on an annual contract (January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020), with Waste Eliminator, Inc., base amount \$7,464,000.00 (negotiated cost savings of approximately \$298,000.00).
- IX. Approval/authorization for the Chairman to execute the Joint Funding Agreement for Water Resources Investigations with U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) for the Long-Term Trend Monitoring Program as required under the County's National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Wastewater Discharge Permits, and in compliance with the Metropolitan North Georgia Water Planning District Water Resources Management Plan in the amount of \$1,224,900.00. USGS is contributing \$160,150.00 and Gwinnett County is contributing \$1,064,750.00. Subject to approval as to form by the Law Department.
- X. Approval to renew RP016-16, consultant demand services on an annual contract (January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020), per the attached recommendation letter, base amount \$20,500,000.00 (negotiated cost savings of approximately \$115,312.00).

- XI. Approval to renew RP013-18, provision of supplemental consultant demand services on an annual contract (January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020), per the attached recommendation letter, base amount \$5,500,000.00 (negotiated cost savings of approximately \$64,000.00).
