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












































































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










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



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
























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- F. Wayne Hill Water Resources Center (WRC) has a single panel slide gate system
- Water Resources Laboratory (WRL) is located outside of the current gate
- Ongoing operational and maintenance issues with the existing gate

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Operational and Maintenance Issues

- · Lengthy cycle times
- Unsafe location of call boxes
- Weight of gate and need to traverse the entire width of roadway results in extensive maintenance of the chain drive system

• Pressure sensor delays





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Project Description

- Demolition of existing asphalt pavement and installation/widening of concrete pavement
- Installation of swing gate system that will provide a shared entrance and exit for the WRC and WRI
- Dedicated call boxes and card readers for each facility within the median
- · Installation of pavement markings and signage
- Installation of chain link fencing
