- Capacity of up to 240 appointments per day
- Monthly evaluation of volume and need

Project RESET 2.0



To date, over 2,500 applications submitted

- \$1 million in assistance awarded, 132 households
- Additional \$3.2 million eligible, 400 households
- Prevented 40+ utility shut-offs
- Intervened in 65+ eviction cases
