For 2025, our highest priority requests of the Board of Commissioners:

1. Budget additional staff positions in 2025-26 to support the new Sustainability Officer. (One approved)
2. Budget \$50,000+ for a Survey of County Businesses to identify and support the best of their sustainability plans.
3. Set a goal for County facilities and vehicles to meet NREL's plan to run on 100% clean energy by 2035.
4. Partner with Georgia Tech (Dr. Garcia) on a climate risk assessment for the County. (in process)

5. Engage the County's School District and regional colleges to ensure our County sustainability goals and actions are aligned with theirs.

6. Where immediate cost savings are available, develop a plan to reduce County LCOE, and Operating Expenses by at least \$3M/yr on average, by installing solar on county buildings and transitioning county fleets to electric vehicles. Then, as taxpayer dollars are saved each year, establish a method to redeploy those funds to limit County households spending on electricity to no more than 20% of their monthly income.
